a. Completed - 1944.

a. On 30 June 1945, 1st Tank Destroyer Group was composed of:

6th Belgian Fusilier Battalion.

f. Effective 111200 July, 433d AAA AW Bn was attached to 1st Tank Destroyer Group for occupational control only. Authority: Cpn Inst #55, 70th Inf Div, 5 July 1945.

g. Effective 121200 July, 127th AAA Gun Bn, 132d AAA Gun Bn, 134th AAA Gun Bn, 433d AAA AW Bn and 447th AAA AW Bn were relieved of attachment to 1st Tank Destroyer Group. Authority: Cpn Inst #56, 70th Inf Div, 11 July 1945.
