SECTION I

1. Composition of Group:

Hq & Hq Co, 1st TD Gp
634 TD Bn - Had not arrived from ENGLAND.

2. a. Mission: None. b. Status: Corps Reserve.

3. Execution: Does not apply.

4. Subsequent Developments:

a. Gp Hc & Mq Co moved from Transit Area "A" to bivouac at (352953). Column closed at 131425B.

b. Continuous reconnaissance of divisional sectors was made by Group staff.

SECTION II

1. Composition of Group:

Hq & Hq Co, 1st TD Gp
63h TD Dm - Had not arrived from ENGLAND.

892 TD Bn - (Attacked 151000B VOCG VII Corps).

2. Mission:

a. Move 899th TD Bn to bivouac in vicinity of Group CP.

5. Be prepared to repel armored attack in 101st A/B Div sector, vicinity of CARMITAN.

3. Execution: 899th TD En moved from ascembly area vicinity of MONTEBOURG to vicinity of LES FORGE (350930). Column closed at 151330B. Terrain reconnaissance was conducted by Group and Battalian staffs for position areas from which an armored attack could be repelled. These positions were never occupied.

2. VOG VII Corps were received relieving five (5) guns of "A" Co, 899th TD

Bn from attachment to 101st A/B Div. These guns reverted to company control at 151800B. At 152205B VOCG VII Corps were received reattaching the same five (5) guns to 101st A/B Div. No movement was made. Battalion Commander was given authority to replace the above mentioned guns by another platoon of "A" Co. This was accomplished at 160330B by substituting 2nd Plat, Co "A".

b. "E" Co, 899th TD Bn was attached to 90th Inf Div at 160600B, VOCG VII Corps.

- c. "C" Co, 899th TD En was attached to 82nd A/B Div at 160600B, VOCG VII Corps.
- d. 2nd Plat, "A" Co, 399th TD Bn reverted to battalion control from attachment to 101st A/B Div at 161500B, VOCG VII Corps.

e. 899th TD Bn (- "B" & "C" Co's) was attached to 9th Inf Div at 171200B, VOCG VII Corps.

f. Plans to repel an armored attack in 101st A/B Div sector remained in effect until 899th TD Bn (-"B" & "C" Co's) was detached from Group and attached to 9th Inf Div at 17120DB.

 a. Group CP moved by infiltration from vicinity FAUVILLE (352953) to new location vicinity E100DEVILLE (336023) beginning at 261313B. Column closed at 261455B.
 - b. 634th TD Bn(-GP vehicles) debarked UTAH BEACH 301400B, and moved to Transit Area "B". Go Hq was notified at 301925B. Battalion was moved to bivouac vicinity EMONDEVILLE (338025). Column closed at 302130B.

c. GP vehicles, 634th TD Bn, debarked UTAH BEACH at 302330B and closed in bivousc area at 010445B.
