643rd TD BATTALION: (Atchd 85rd Inf. Div.)

Bn. at same location under same attachment entire period. Unit converted to self-propolled effective 22 Feb. 45. Three (5) platoons converted during period and personnel rendered excess were transferred to units of the 83rd Inf. Div. One (1) platoon of each co. reorganized and re-equipped as SP and familiarization firing with the primary weapon completed during period. "B" and "C" Co's supporting 330th and 331st Inf respectively. At close of period "C" in assembly vio HONGEN and "B" Co. with forward elements of 330th Inf. No enemy armor encountered during period.

702nd TD BATTALION: (Atchd 2nd TD Group

Location at end of Period: F105546

At the beginning of the period Bn at DURBOSIAR, GERMANY with platoons disposed along Corps front line, in indirect and direct fire positions. Preparations for ROER RIVER crossing operation completed. Co's "A", "B", and "C" remained in same location from 181200A Feb to 221200A Feb making final preparations for direct and indirect support of the 29th and 30th Inf Division's assault across the ROER RIVER in vio JULICH. 230245A Feb, Co's "B" and "C" in direct and indirect support assisted in the preparatory fires of the Corps Arty in the drive of the 29th and 30th Inf Div. Co "C" and Co "A" fired direct fires on enemy installations and vehicles across the river on call from ferward observers and from supported units. From 23 Feb to 251200A Feb, Co's "A", "B", and "C" continued indirect fire missions from order of the 2nd TD Group Fire Control Center.

During this period 7,412 rounds of 90mm HE fired by the three (3) Cots excitordinates) assisting materially in the successful assault of the bridgehead, and reports later received indicated the fire laid on roads in vic of STENSTRASS by those units was the direct result of the failure of two (2) enemy batteries of 150mm guns to successfully withdraw, and were captured by the advancing Inf. Co "C" reverted to control of CC "B", 2nd Armored Div. afternoon of 25th Feb. - prepared to support CC "B" in the defense of the right flank of the 30th Inf Div. No enemy armor encountered during period.

At beginning of the period unit atohd 2nd TD Group, in assembly

"A" Co moved into indirect fire positions in support of 30th Div and "B" and "C" Co's the same in support of 29th Div = all under Group and Corps Arty. 23rd Feb, "A" Co. fired 1212 rounds HE NO, "B" Co 992 rounds, and "C" Co 1150 rounds on interdiction and harassing fires. 231645 "B" Co atchd 29th Div and entered assembly position. 3096 rounds HE NO were fired by "A" and "C" Co's 25th Feb unit was attached to 115th Cav. Group and moved to NIEDERZIER, KRAUTHAUSEN, and FIER to pretect 30th Div. right flank. No enemy armor encountered during period.

821et TD BATTALION: (Atchd 29th Inf. Div.) Location at end of Period: POLATOR (Coordinates)

At beginning of period Em. in DURBOSIAR, GERNANY, atchd 29th Inf Div, preparing for ROER RIVER crossing operation. Before attack 1-A and 2-A in indirect fire positions fired harassing and interdiction fire in support of river crossing, firing a total of 35 missions, for an expenditure of 2074 rounds 5" HE during period. Co. relieved of indirect mission and crossed ROER RIVER at 241452A hours in direct support of 29th Inf Div. B-1 and B-2 in indirect fire positions before attack fired a total of 36 missions, for an expenditure of 2155 rounds 5" HE. Co. relieved of indirect mission and crossed ROER RIVER at 250800M in direct support of 116th Inf. "C" Co. atchd 175th Inf for river crossing operation - crossed river 241142A hours in direct support of 175th and 116th Inf. Unit fired direct on strong points, blasting houses the continues of 15th Inf. Unit fired direct on strong points, blasting houses (Coordinates)

and dug-in tank guns. Ren Co platoons operated with gun companies, establishing OP's in platoon sectors. Before gun Co's crossed river, Ren sent patrols across behind the assaulting Inf and made ren routes to position areas for Co's "A" and "C", clearing mines in position areas, platoons maintaining contact with assaulting Inf and established OP's on objectives.

At beginning of period En at K968499 under same attachment, preparing for attack across ROER RIVER. Two (2) M-10's for Co "A" and four (4) M-10's for Co "C" received during period made 100% conversion to SP for the En. All excess equipment rendered surplus by the conversion to SP was turned in and maintenance and training carried on in all Co's prior to attack on ROER RIVER. "B" Co. prior to attack, was en secondary mission, firing 34 concentrations for a total of 4733 rounds. Unit released from secondary mission at 1700 23 Feb and crossed ROER RIVER early morning of 24th. From direct fire positions vic NIEDERZIER B-1 fired 25 rounds IE claiming one (1) pillbox, two (2) MG nests and two (2) 20mm AA guns destroyed. "C" Co atchd to 117th Inf Regt, on accordance mission prior to attack - firing 69 concentrations for a total of

5468 rounds HE. At end of period unit engaged in fire fight claiming one (1) Mk IV destroyed and one (1) Mk VI disabled. Ron Co furnished FO's for ROER RIVER crossing operation. At close of period Bn supporting attack of 30th Inf Div with units on all Div objectives and disposed in depth in Div sector - Co's atchd as follows: "A" Co 119th Inf: "B" Co 120th Inf: and "C" Co 117th Inf.
