1. BREWY: Principle armored activity occurred during the first half of the month while establishing the so called "Falaise Pocket". All available armored units were concentrated here and were used primarily in support of units fighting delaying actions, and maintaining the shoulders of the gap. The air force, artillery, and tank destroyer units inflicted much damage during the period, probably destroying about 80% of the enemy's remaining armor. After withdrawal from the gap, and during the German retreat to the EAST which is still in progress, armor was not used for attack purposes. It was accepted that the gasoline situation was so critical that, while gas could be supplied for withdrawal purposes, none could be spared for operational use. This appears to still be the case. Elements of all units are reported from all our fronts and it is evident that divisions have ceased to exist as tactical entities. At the end of the month JW statements and radio intercepts indicate that reorganization is in progress to the EAST and it is expected that shortly battle groups will appear composed of the remnants of several divisions. It is estimated that between 150-200 tanks may have escaped to be regrouped.

Letter companies of the Bn. are used to form combat forces. Unit provided direct support for advancing Inf. Regts. protected Corps front and flank against hostile armor, and fired harassing and interdictory fires at night.

f. Results of Operations: Exploitation of armored force "break through" continued. Tank Destroyer Units provided support against hostile armor and performed varied missions in a very satisfactory manner. During period Tank Destroyer Units destroyed five (5) enemy tanks, two (2) Self-Propelled guns, ten (10) armored vehicles, thirty-six (36) GP vehicles, two (2) pillboxes, and eight (8) MG emplacements; fired 528 rounds in direct fire and 4,671 rounds in harassing and interdictory fires; captured 632 prisoners, and had the following casualties:
