B. Operations for Period:

1 Mar 1945:

1. Co A, with 2nd Rcn plat.
  - (a) Contd D/S of 347th Inf Regt.
  - (b) 1st plat, in conjunction with one plat of tanks, formed two armored groups consisting of two medium tanks and two tank destroyers. One group was lead by tank plat leader and one lead by tank destroyer plat leader. These two groups moved in support of the Inf as it assaulted the town of ORMONT (0692). The 1st plat destroyers fired 12 rds HE, 14 rds APC and 2000 rds .50 MG at 5 pillboxes (1 in ORMONT, 1 on high ground 500 yds East of ORMONT, 3 on high ground 1000 yds South of ORMONT). At close of period 2 destroyers were in ORMONT covering North approaches to town, 2 destroyers on the high ground 500 yds East of ORMONT.
    - (c) 2nd plat moved 1 destroyer to (073914) to cover rear of 2nd Bn 347th Inf, and 2 destroyers to CR(064894).
2. Co B, with 3rd Rcn plat atchd.
  - (a) Contd D/S of 346th Inf Regt.
  - (b) Plats contd rcn for routes to join Inf Bns. Several attempts to get destroyers up with Inf failed due to impassable terrain.
3. Co C, with 1st Rcn plat atchd.
  - (a) Contd D/S of 345th Inf Regt.
  - (b) 2nd plat moved 2 destroyers to (094906) and 2 destroyers to (097902) to cover East approaches to 2nd Bn 345th Inf area.
  - (c) 3rd plat moved 1 gun to vic of 3 houses Northeast of NEUENDORF (095881) to cover road leading into NEUENDORF.

  - (a) Contd D/S of 347th Inf. Fired 24 rds of APC at pillboxes and enemy strong points in vic of ORMONT (0692). 2nd plat assembled at CR(073914).

  - (a) Contd D/S of 346th Inf Regt. All plats assembled in vic (092918). Contd rcn to find routes to East. Prepared to move as roads are cleared of mines and obstacles.

  - (a) Contd D/S of 345th Inf Regt. Fired 100 rds of .50 cal into woods in spt of Inf. 1st plat moved 2 destroyers to vic (100911).

3 Mar 1945:

  - (b) 1st plat, sptng the Inf, fired 15 rds APC and 44 rds HE at pillboxes to North and East of ORMONT.
  - (c) 2nd plat, sptng Inf, fired 69 rds APC at several pillboxes. 4 of the pillboxes were destroyed.
  - (d) 3rd plat moved 1 destroyer to ROTH (0790).
2. Co B, with 3rd Rcn plat atchd.
  - (a) Contd D/S of 346th Inf Regt.
  - (b) 1st plat attempted to move up with Inf, could not find route. Assembled at (096934).
  - (c) 2nd plat moved 2 destroyers to (095932) and 2 destroyers to (102902) to cover the flank of the Regt.
  - (d) 3rd plat fired harrassing preparation fire for 3rd Rn 346th Inf at pillboxes and enemy strong points on hill 649 at (092937). Later occupied hill with Inf. Fired 39 rds HE, 39 rds APC in this sptng fire.

  - (b) 1st plat accompanied 3rd Bn to its objective, then returned to ORMONT (0892) on order of the Inf CO.
  - (c) 2nd plat accompanied Inf toward objective at SCHEID (0695) until stopped by terrain and prepared obstacles. Plat contd rcn and made its way to objective at (050600).
  - (d) 3rd plat moved in spt of Inf to its objective at HALLSCHLAG (0795).
  - (e) Company fired 7 rds HE, 89 APC and 1500 rds of .50 cal at pillboxes and enemy strong points in the area.
3. Co B, with 3rd Rcn plat.
  - (a) Contd D/S of 346th Inf Regt.
  - (b) 1st plat moved in spt of the Inf to KRONENBURGERHUTTE (1096), could not proceed due to blown bridge.
  - (c) 2nd plat moved in spt of Inf to pos in vic (122930).
  - (d) 3rd plat moved with assaulting troops into KERSCHENBACH (1295). In this operation 1 destroyer was hit by enemy arty and burned.
  - (e) Company fired 20 rds HE, 1 APC and 700 rds .50 cal into houses, woods and enemy strong points in its area. Captured 4 FW's.

  - (a) Atchd to 28th Inf Div.
  - (b) At 191300 Co moved to PLAIDT (7599). Closed in assembly area at 191500.

2. Co A, with 2nd Rcn plat atchd. (atchd to 347th Inf Regt).
  - (a) Sptd Regt in crossing of the RHINE RIVER, firing at targets of opportunity. Fired 110 rds of 90mm HE, 50 rds APC and 625 rds of .50 cal MG, neutralizing 1 20mm AA gun, 1 mortar, 1 en OP and fired into enemy held buildings in the vic of OBER-LAHNSTEIN.
  - (b) Plats ferried across the RHINE R and moved to positions to spt Inf Bns, 1st plat at (925899), 2nd at (920889), 3rd plat at (932863).
3. Co B -
  - (a) Assembled in vic (887785).
  - (b) Two (2) plats moved across RHINE R to spt 346th Inf; assembled on East side of river to await Inf crossing.
4. Co C, with 1st Rcn plat atchd. (atchd to 345th Inf Regt).
  - (a) Spted Regt crossing of RHINE R with fire. Fired 7 rds of 90mm HE at en personnel.
  - (b) Plats crossed river by ferry and moved to join Inf Bns at (970817) for 1st plat, (937808) for 2nd, and the 3rd plat at LYKERSHAUSEN (9478).

26 Mar 1945:

1. Bn, less Co A & C, atchd to Task Force SUNDT.
2. Co A, with 2nd Rcn plat atchd.
  - (a) Atchd to 347th Inf Regt.
  - (b) Co CP moved to RHENS (8792).
  - (c) 1st plat formed with a Task Force consisting of 1 plat of tks and 1 plat of TD's and 2 plats of Inf with the objective of BAD EMS (9994). Two road blocks were encountered and reduced. The Task Force reached their objective of BAD EMS at 1400.
  - (d) 2nd plat moved to spt 2nd Bn 347th Inf, reaching the high ground East of

26 Mar 1945, cont'd

(par 2.(d))

LAHNSTEIN (9091) at 0600. To reach the Bn the plat had to move over a road that had not been swept for mines, through heavy 20mm AA fire, and push through a section of OBERLAHNSTEIN that had not been taken.

(e) 3rd plat - Formed a Task Force similar to that of the 1st plat with the objective of FRUZHT (9196) which was reached about 1100 encountering light resistance in the town. At 1300 one half of the Task Force moved into the town of NIEVERN (9693), returning to FRUZHT after securing NIEVERN.

3. Co C, with 1st Rcn plat atchd.

(a) Atchd to 345th Inf Regt.

(b) Co CP at WINTERWERB (0081).

(c) 1st plat was formed in a task force consisting of Tanks, TD's and Inf with the mission of taking MIEHLEN (9396). The Task Force moved out at 1000 and proceeded, meeting only light small arms resistance until reaching the objective. The Force was delayed in rounding up PW's, firing several rounds of 90mm HE and some .50 to persuade them to come in. Orders were received to move on to BETTENDORF (8200). BETTENDORF was reached at 1700. The plat fired 19 rds HE, 1 APC and 450 rds .50 cal at enemy personnel and houses.

(d) 2nd & 3rd plats formed up in a Task Force with the objective of GEISIG (8594) and MARIENFELS (8395). The Task Force moved out at 0930 and encountered no opposition until reaching the town of NDR-BACHEIM (8392). Here it encountered direct AT fire and 20mm AA fire plus mortar fire. The tanks and TD's deployed and took the weapons under fire. The 2nd plat knocked out 2 AT guns, 2 quadruple 20mm flack guns. The TF reached its objective by 1600. At 1630 orders were received to take the town of POHL (8499). This was accomplished by 1800 without incident. During the operation the 2nd plat knocked out 1 enemy truck.

27 Mar 1945:

1. Bn, less Co A & C, atchd to Task Force SUNDT.

2. Co A, with 2nd Rcn plat atchd.

(a) 1st plat still working with Task Force moved along LAHN RIVER to LIMBURG (9923).

(b) 2nd plat - 2 destroyers were left in overwatch position and 2 destroyers with Inf attacked the town of OBR-LAHNSTEIN from the East, continuing on thru the town and assisting in mopping up. In this operation they destroyed 10 20mm AA guns and 1 AT gun.

(c) 3rd plat moved along LAHN RIVER with Inf to KAMBERG (8938).

3. Co C, with 1st Rcn plat atchd.

(a) 1st plat moved to ZOLLHAUS (877233) with TF encountering no resistance.

(b) 2nd plat moved to HAHNSTATTEN (9024).

(c) 3rd plat moved to 2000 yds West of ZOLLHAUS.

(d) Co CP moved to ALLENDORF (8618).

28 Mar 1945:

1. Bn, less Co A & C, atchd to Task Force Sundt.

(a) Co A, with 2nd Rcn plat atchd.

(b) 1st plat moved with TF and cleared out WEILMUNSTER (0448) arriving at 1700.

(c) 2nd plat moved to CR (975895) where it transferred to reserve. Later the plat was relieved from atchmt to 347th Inf Regt and atchd to 346th. After moving in spt of Inf Bn arrived at OBR-QUEMBACH (0853).

(d) 3rd plat formed a Task Force with its TD's and approximately 1 plat of

28 Mar 1945, cont'd

Inf with the objective of GUISSEN (2065). The TF began movement at 1300 and completed the mission at 2000.

2. Co C, with 1st Rcn plat atchd.

(a) Co formed with one Co of tanks and Bn of Inf to form a Task Force with the objective of BUTZBACH. The Inf was mounted on tanks, TD's and trucks. At 0730 the TF moved out and proceeded to NEIDERSELTERS (9335) where, at 0900, it ran into heavy resistance consisting of small arms, mortars, AT and artillery fire. The TD's and tks moved to positions to spt Inf. One tank was hit and disabled by AT fire. Sgt Sue with his TD had the mission of covering the tanks, spotted the AT gun and destroyed it with direct HE fire. At 1900 a coordinated attack was launched including MG and 90mm fire on the position. At 2100 all resistance had ceased. Co bivouacked for the night in NIEDERSELT\* ers. The Co CP was at DAUBORN. During the action the Co captured 12 PW's. The Co communications was used as the Task Force communications.

29 Mar 1945:

(a) Co still formed a part of Task Force. Continued movement on BUTZBACH (0567). The Force moved to its objective, arriving at 1340. It received orders at 1600 to return to BRANDOBERNDORF (0554).

30 Mar 1945:

1. All Task Force and combat team attachments ceased. Bn assembled in vicinity of KLEEBERG (0658).

31 Mar 1945:


1. Bn assembled at KLEEBERG. Conducted maintenance, patrolled woods in vicinity and checked towns in area.

C. Results of Operations for Period:

1. Bn (- Task Force Sundt) fired 1064 rds 90mm HE, 366 Rds APC, 3 rds T105 in spt of Inf Regts.

2. Destroyed 9 pillboxes, 2 AA Guns, 3 AT guns, 2 general purpose vehicles.
