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

On the night of 4 February 1945, LIEUTENANT KEEBY was in command of a raiding party whose mission was to capture the energy located in a mill between * * * and * * *, France. LIEUTENANT KEEBY brilliantly planned and executed the raid, maintaining the enthusiasm of the raiding party throughout the entire action. He led his patrol to the mill and was with the initial assault elements when they entered the enemy strongpoint. In the fight that followed, LIEUTENANT KEEBY quickly disposed of one of the enemy by a well placed hand grenade. His resourcefulness materially assisted in capturing six of the enemy and in obtaining valuable information. His actions were in accordance with the highest traditions of the military service.
