- 1. During the period 1-30 September 1944 this battalion was assigned to First U. S. Army and attached to V Corps with further attachments (for operations only) as follows:
 - a. 1-13 September 1944 5th Armored Division and further attached as follows:
 - (1) 1-5 September 1944 Company C attached to Combat Command *R*.
 - b. 14-30 September 1944 28th Infantry Division.
 - 2. Indirect fire missions as follows:
 - a. Company A fired 62 missions (445 rds) harassing fires.
- 3. Battalion performed direct fire missions constantly during period inflicting losses against the enemy as follows:
