II - AWARD OF SILVER STAR MEDAL

II - AWARD OF SILVER STAR MEDAL: By direction of the president and under the provisions of AR 600-45, as amended, and Memorandum 34, Headquarters Ninth United States Army, 8 September 1944, as amended, the Silver Star Medal is awarded to:

Private First Class JOHN E HIBBS 35110601 (then Private), 638th Tank Destroyer Battalion (Attached 84th Infantry Division), United States Army. For gallantry in action against the enemy in Belgium, 24 December 1944. During a hand-to-hand engagement with the enemy, Private First Class Hibbs, under a barrage of artillery and mortar fire, destroyed an enemy machine gun and killed the entire crew with rifle grenades. Later, while under heavy sniper fire, he killed an additional five Germans who were attempting to set up another machine gun position. Returning for additional ammunition, Private First Class Hibbs located a concealed enemy self-propelled gun and, again firing rifle grenades, he forced the enemy gun into the field of fire of a tank destroyer which disabled the enemy weapon and killed the crew. At this point, the tank destroyer was subjected to heavy mortar fire and the crew was forced to abandon the vehicle when it failed to start. Private First Class Hibbs climbed in the drivers seat, remedied the deficiency and drove the destroyer out of range of fire of an approaching enemy tank and squad of Germans intent on capturing the vehicle. Later, while withdrawing from the village with his platoon under heavy machine gun and mortar fire. Private First Class Hibbs received a slight wound. The disdain for danger, tenacious fighting spirit and exemplary actions displayed by Private First Class Hibbs reflect the highest credit upon himself and the armed forces of the United States. Entered military service from Kentucky.


