

## FIRE ORDERS

- l. All fire orders issued prior to this date are hereby resinded. The following will be in effect, and will be read, obeyed and respected accordingly by all members of this command. These orders will be posted. In reference to fire fighting all Officers should familiarize themselves with the following list of references, Administrative Memorandum #37 HQ, TDC, Camp Hood, Tex. 13 Sept 43. Administrative Memorandum #53 HQ, TD ITC, North Camp Hood, Texas 13 Sept 43.
- 2. The Battalion is located in area #6, North Camp Hood. Texas, in the event of a fire the alarm will be sounded, Battalion O.D. or Fire Marshall will be informed of the location of the fire Each company will send ten (10) men to the fire under the command of a responsible NCO. Occupants and supplies will be removed from the burning tent or structure and adjoining tents will be grounded. The fire alarm will be located near Battalion Headquarters, CP.
- 3. Company Commanders will be responsible for the area under their command. Battalion Motor Officer will be responsible for the Motor Park. The Adjutant will be responsible for Battalion Headquarters, unit commanders will be responsible for fire fighting equipment in their area, also for the instruction of fire prevention in their unit. For the operation of each range, field M1937, three (3) buckets of sand per range will be kept in the near vicinity. Unit commanders should be well supplied with the following types of fire fighting equipment, axes, pick, mattocks, shovels, bucket galvanized, sacks, burlap and other equipment for fighting gas, oil, wood, tent or forrest fires. Commanders will supervise all fire drills by getting the fire fighting detail, and necessary equipment together in the shortest possible time. One bucket of water will be placed at the entrance of each tent in the area.
