Summary of Operations: 1 November 1944 to 30 November 1944.

(Note: All coordinates listed are found in the Nord de Guerre grid system in the 500 kilometer square (1). The letters preceding coordinates in this narrative designate the 100 kilometer square within the above outlined area).

1 Nov 44. - 100410Z: 3m (less 1, 2, 3) via Bremen, Germany (K938379).

3 Co (less 3d Lt) via Bremen, Germany (K931408),  
3d Lt via Bremen, Germany (K915390).

3 Co (less 1st & 3d Lts) via Bremen, Germany  
(K923382). 1st Lt via Bremen, Germany (K957418).

3d Lt via Bremen, Germany (K933382).

3 Co via Bremen, Germany (K922371).

Assignment of Troops: 3d and 3e Lt were attached to  
3 Comd 1, 3d S; 3d Co had 2d Lt on attached to  
3 Comd 2, 3d S; 3n (less 1, 2, 3) and two Lts (on)  
attached to division reserve (3 Comd 1) 3e Lt.

3d Lt of 3 Co, relieved the 1st Lt of 3 Co, at 1100 hours. 3d Lt of 3 Co not located via of 370330 (K957418). 1st Lt  
of 3 Co returned to via of Company 3.

2nd and 3rd Lts of 3 Co moved into positions for indirect firing at 1140 hours. 2nd Lt via (K905357), 3rd Lt F Co via (K897357).

3rd Lt A Co fired 390 rds in during period, in harassing and  
interdiction missions via of 370330, Germany (K9047).

2 Nov 44. - 2nd and 3rd Lts A Co expended registration and harassing  
missions during period. 117 rds expended.

3rd Lt A Co fired 370 rds in on a position in counter-battery missions.

During the period, two snailtraps were in order — one (1) was avoided by enemy arty.

3 Nov 44. - 2nd and 3rd Lts A Co expended 240 rds 100. 3rd Lt A Co  
expended 131 rds 100.

Heavy planes were overhead at 2010 hours. no (1) wounded by  
falling flak.

4 Nov 44. - 3rd Lt A Co expended 319 rds 100.

Heavy planes overhead at 2210 hours, bombs were dropped—but none in  
vic of this unit.

5 Nov 44. - Heavy heavy artillery (150mm) fell in immediate vicinity  
of 3d Lt at 1010 hours. no casualties.

3rd Lt A Co relieved by composite platoon of 3d Lt 1030 hrs.

3rd Lt A Co returned to via of Company 3.

A Co expended 160 rds 100.

2nd & 3rd Lts A Co expended 483 rds 100.

6 Nov 44. - A Co expended 247 rds 100. 2nd & 3rd Lts A Co expended  
255 rds 100.

7 Nov 44. - A Co expended 260 rds 100. 2nd & 3rd Lts A Co expended  
497 rds 100.

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8 Nov 44. - 2nd Plt C Co relieved 3rd Plt C Co at 1100 hours. 2nd Plt now at vic (A968418) via STETTERBURG, Germany. 3rd Plt C Co returned to vic of Company C. C Co expended 472 rds HE.

9 Nov 44. - C Co expended 435 rds HE. 2nd & 3rd Plts B Co expended 408 rds HE.

10 Nov 44. - C Co composite platoon relieved of mission at 1030 hours and returned to vic of Co C.  
Received T.O. No. 16, HQ 3d AD at 1300 hours.  
HQ C Co held meeting of Co Comdr's and Staff Officers at 1400 hours to discuss T.O. No. 16.  
2nd Plt C Co expended 510 rds HE.  
1st Plt C Co moved to vic STETTERBURG (A962413) at 1300 hours.  
C Co to support attack of 3 Comdr B, 3rd AD. 1st Plt C Co attached to 2nd Bn, 35th Armd Regt, 2nd Plt C Co attached to 1st Bn, 33rd Armd Regt, 3rd Plt C Co in Combat Command Reserve.  
3rd Plt C Co moved to vic of STETTERBURG (A958412) at 1500 hours.

11 Nov 44. - 2nd and 3rd Plts B Co expended 255 rds HE. 1st Plt C Co relieved 3rd Plt C Co at 1300 hours. 3rd Plt C Co returned to vicinity of Company C.

12 Nov 44. - 2nd Plt C Co attached to T.P. HIGGIN (Div Res, 3d AD, but remained at indirect firing position until called to assemble with the task force.  
3rd Plt C Co attached to T.P. KANE (Div Res) and is also awaiting orders to assemble.  
1st Plt C Co will fire 500 rds HE on harassing missions the night of D Day.  
C Co expended 523 rds HE.

13 Nov 44. - C Co expended 39 rds HE.

14 Nov 44. - C Co expended 207 rds HE.

15 Nov 44. - No activity - awaiting orders to attack.

16 Nov 44. - Received message that H Hour was 1245 hours. VII Corps attacked after heavy air and artillery preparations.  
2nd Plt C Co joined 1st Plt C Co at 1540 hours, assembled at A801, Germany (A972413).  
3rd Plt C Co joined T.P. C Co at 1600 hours, assembled at A80083, Germany (A962411).  
Combat Command 3, 3d AD, pushed out rapidly to gain the objective RUITZ (A975448), KIRCH (A975450), KIRCH (A984449), KIRCH (A975451). Right column had secured its objective by 1400 hours, but left column was slowed down by mine field and had to by-pass to the west. At close of period 1st Plt C Co located vic of KIRCH (A965429), and 2nd Plt C Co vic KIRCH 282 (A952421), 3rd Plt C Co vic KIRCH (A975431).  
1st Plt C Co fired 500 rds HE on harassing missions during hours of darkness 16 - 17 Nov 44, plus 121 rds fired prior to H-hour on the 16th.

17 Nov 44. - 1st Plt C Co assembled at C Co at 1000 hours.  
At 1200 hours C Co's platoons had moved to the following locations:  
1st Plt vic (A964428), 1st and 3rd Plts (A977455).  
By 1330 hrs 1st Plt C Co had reached vic of KIRCH (A983447) and at 2100 hrs were located vic of KIRCH (A976446). 2nd Plt C Co located vic KIRCH (A973441), 3rd Plt C Co located vic KIRCH (A975430).  
No change remainder of Battalion.

18 Nov 44. - All three platoons of C Co located vic of WERTH (K978-436) at 1200 hours.

1st Plt C Co knocked out one (1) PzKw V at range of 3200 yds, and one (1) S.P. Gun (75mm Howitzer on Half-track chassis) at 3500 yds. Expended 2nd Plt C Co destroyed one (1) towed A.T. Gun (75mm T) at 600 yds range. One (1) WO wounded and evacuated. Total ammo expended by 1st Plt & 2nd Plt C Co was 100 rds APCBDF plus 69 rds HE.

19 Nov 44. - No change.

20 Nov 44. - 2nd Plt A Co joined T.P. "Y" (3rd Bn, 32nd Armd Regt) in vic of BRAUNIG, Germany (K948392) at 0800 hours.  
2nd Plt C Co moved to vic of HASTENRATH (K976445) during period.

21 Nov 44. - All units planning for future operations.

22 Nov 44. - No change.

23 Nov 44. - No change.

24 Nov 44. - 2nd Plt A Co moved out with T.P. "Y", C Comd "A" to assemble in vic of NOTHERG (K985464) at 1400 hours. This force attacked at 1445 hours to secure the high ground between LANGERKHE (P030475) and FRENZ (P018497) and had reached vic of (P001474) by 1700 hours. Enemy opposition consisted of minefields, A.T. Arty and small arms fire. Attack was to be resumed at 250830. At 0930 hours 3rd Plt B Co moved to vic of STYLBURG (K938422) at 1700 hours.

Remainder of Battalion no change.

25 Nov 44. - 2nd Plt C Co moved forward in attack with T.P. "Y", C Comd A and reported its position at 1700 hours, to be, vic of SEIS-BILF (P001474).

Remainder of Bn no change.

26 Nov 44. - 2nd Plt A Co continued supporting attack of T.P. "Y", C Comd A and was in position at vic of SEIS-BILF (P012432) at 1130 hours. From this position they are to protect right flank of Task Force and provide covering fire for advance of tanks to objective. Plt Mgr WO. two (2) M of 2nd Plt A Co were wounded—one WO remained for duty—remainder evacuated.

Remainder of Bn no change.

27 Nov 44. - T.P. "Y", C Comd A, was relieved on its objective by elements of 1st Infantry Division. 2nd Plt "A" Co assembled at vic BRAUNIG-BURG (K948392) at 1215 hours.

Remainder of Bn no change.

28 Nov 44. - No change.

29 Nov 44. - No change.

30 Nov 44. - No change.
