1. a. Use current intelligence reports and altitudes.
 - b. (1) 7th Inf Div will sweep from southeast corner [REDACTED] north to hills immediately north of [REDACTED] with 90th Inf Bn on left (north) and 7th Inf Div on right (south).
 - (2) 7th Inf Div will sweep northeast in its zone of action as regulated by phase lines.
 - (3) 1st Bn [REDACTED], at 250750Z June 1945 commence sweep northeast from [REDACTED], picking up remaining [REDACTED] units and personnel, arriving [REDACTED] at 271800Z June 1945; resume sweep northeast from [REDACTED] at 280750Z June 1945.
 - (4) 2nd Bn [REDACTED], at 250750Z June 1945 commence sweep northeast from [REDACTED], picking up remaining [REDACTED] units and personnel, arriving [REDACTED] at 271800Z June 1945; resume sweep northeast from [REDACTED] at 280750Z June 1945.
 - (5) 3rd Bn [REDACTED] will establish outposts on line [REDACTED] - [REDACTED]; at 250750Z June 1945 commence sweep northeast from [REDACTED], picking up remaining [REDACTED] units and personnel, arriving [REDACTED] at 271800Z June 1945; resume sweep northeast at 280750Z June 1945.
 - (6) 4th Bn [REDACTED] will, at 280750Z commence sweep northeast within assigned zone.
2. 728th Amphibian tractor in [REDACTED] company B, 776 Amphibian tank in [REDACTED] is relieved of present mission of beach defense and will:
 - a. sweep assigned sector of 7th Inf Div zone of action, completing same by 30 June 1945.
 - b. by 251200Z June 1945 establish ambushes and road blocks along [REDACTED] north boundary from [REDACTED] (8395) inclusive, to the coast to prevent movement of hostile troops to the north.
 - c. continue present mission of furnishing [REDACTED] for logistical utilization by elements of [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] via [REDACTED].
3. a. [REDACTED] Amph [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]:
 - (1) with one [REDACTED] plate, sweep assigned sector of [REDACTED] in same [REDACTED] as shown on [REDACTED] operational overlay, completing same by 30 June 1945.
 - (2) by 251200Z June 1945 establish ambushes and road blocks along [REDACTED] north boundary with two [REDACTED] plates abreast, within area of responsibility as shown on [REDACTED] operational overlay, to prevent movement of hostile troops to the north.
 - (3) establish and maintain physical contact with elements of [REDACTED] on the right (south).
 - (4) continue presently assigned missions of elements via [REDACTED].

- b. **30 720 Amph Bn (A) will:**
 - (1) With no platoon sweep assigned sector of BN area as shown on atchd operational overlay, displacing platoon to vicinity of area to be swept, and completing sweep by 30 June 1945.
 - (2) By 251200Z June 1945 establish ambushes and road blocks along the 1000 north boundary with two platoons abreast, within area of responsibility as shown on atchd operational overlay, to prevent movement of hostile troops to the north.
 - (3) Continue presently assigned missions of elements via **YANBA.**
 - c. Field trains will continue presently assigned missions.
 - d. **30 776 Amph Bn (A) will:**
 - (1) Sweep assigned sector of 720 Amph Bn area as shown on atchd operational overlay, completing same by 30 June 1945.
 - (2) Establish ambushes and road blocks along the line **100666666 - 24** at 251200Z June 1945 to prevent movement of hostile troops to north.
 - x. (1) The word "sweep" as used in this order will be interpreted to include the following:
 - a. Full application of the provisions of par 4 particularly concerning friendly and hostile material.
 - b. Destroying all enemy installations and caves which may be utilized to harbor hostile stragglers.
 - c. Assembling and escorting to collecting point all civilians encountered outside the limits of **1000** area.
 - d. Killing all enemy dead.
 - (2) All units will patrol daily their perimeters within 500 yards of bivouac areas. In this patrolling, the provisions of 3x (1) will be executed.
 - (3) All personnel will be informed that reports have been confirmed that our soldiers have been directed to infiltrate in mass into our lines for the purpose of inflicting casualties and destroying installations and equipment.
 - (4) All individuals will have weapons always at hand and every precaution will be taken against attack or ambush of patrols and working parties.

- b. Apply:
 - a. Vaccination
 - (1) Friendly casualties to **DIR SA YANBARU** beach
 - (2) Enemy casualties to **BN CP**
 - c. Salvage
 - (1) Personal small cases and ammo containers complete with caps to the temporary collecting point at **1003611**. Fibre and wooden ammo cases will be destroyed by burning and area thoroughly polished. Units will furnish own transportation for this work.
 - d. Captured material
 - (1) Enemy ammo and explosives not destroyed or sealed in caves to temporary **CP** at **1003611**, reported to **3-3**.
 - (2) Material, including weapons, of intelligence value, to **BN CP**.
 - (3) Location of material not able to be accounted or destroyed, reported to **3-3**.
 - e. Casualties
 - (1) Missing - no change
 - (2) Enemy dead - by units within assigned zones, reported to **3-3**. **UNIT** records will be used.

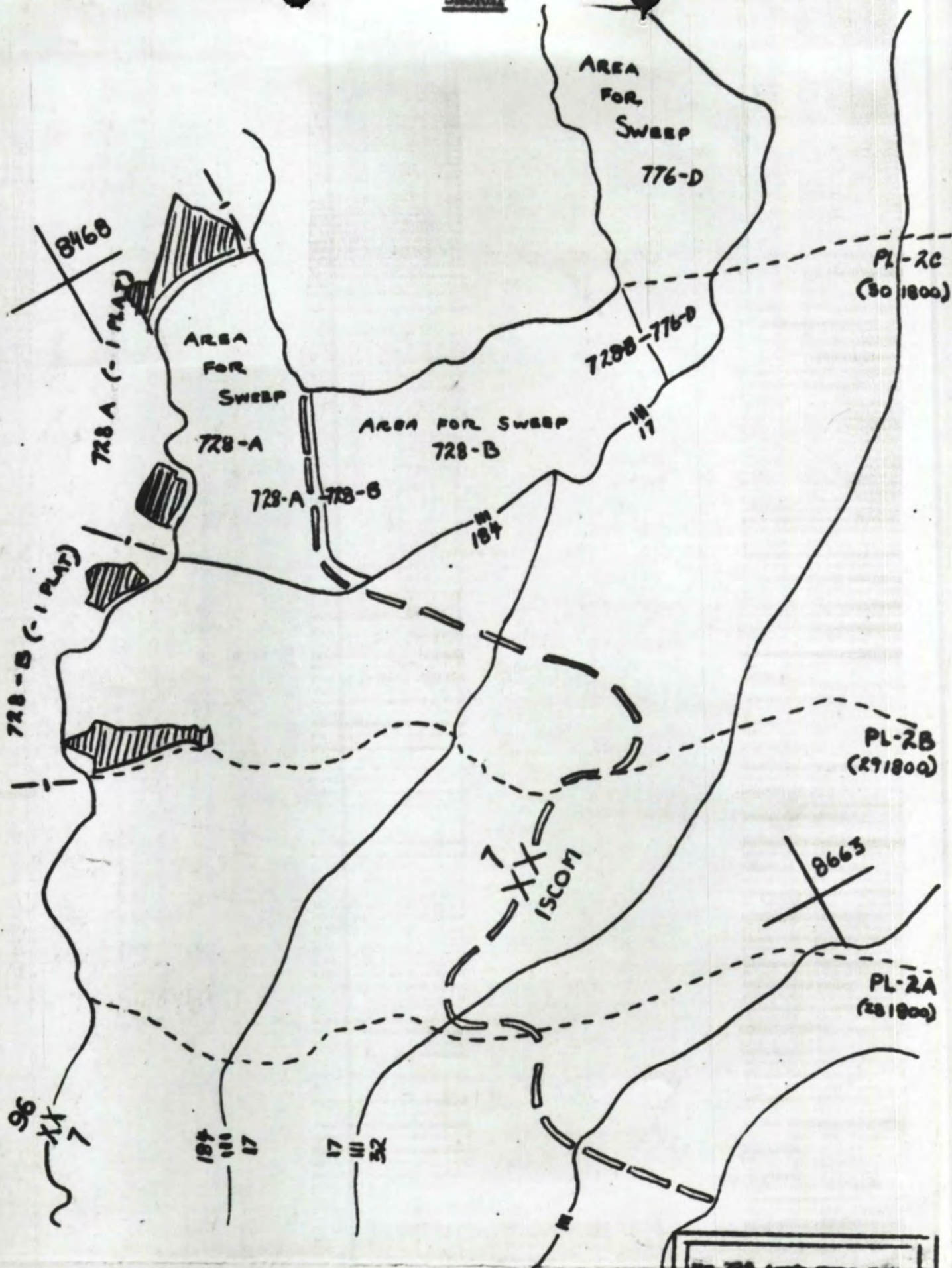
