Paragraph 2a (1) new reads "SC 13th and SC 1323 which will mark the LOD at the centre of Beaches WHITE 1 and WHITE 2 & 3 respectively" change to read "SCI31h and SC 1323 which will mark the LOD and the right flank of BEACH WHITE 1 and the centre of BEACHES WHITE 2 & 3 respectively."

- 1. a. Annex Biker (Intelligence).
 - b. (1) Tenth Army, composed of XXIV Corps (Reinf), III Phib Corps (Reinf), 77th Inf Div (Reinf), 2d Mar Div (Reinf), 27th Inf Div and 81st Inf Div, Lt. Gon. Simon B. Buckner, Commanding, Expeditionary Troops, ICEBERG, has been directed to assist in the capture, occupation, defense and development of CKINAL IS and establishment of control of the sea and air in the IMINEI SHOTO (RIUKYU) area with the eventual aim of extending control of the IMPSEI SHOTO by capturing, defending and developing additional positions.

(2) Landing Operations in MINSEL SHOTO are to be preceded by shore-based air, and mayal air and surface bembardment of objectives in FORMOSA, the MINSEL SHOTO, and the KYUSHU-WISTERM HOMSHU area.

- (3) Phases of the operation:
 - (a) Phasa t
 - (1) On L 6 Day, the capture of the islands of KERAIN RETTO for use as an advanced naval anchorage and sea plane base.
 - (2) Not later than L-1 Day, the capture of the islands of KEISE and emplacement of heavy artillary for support of operations on OKIMA.
 - (3) On L Day, landing on the western shore of OKINGE with Corps abreast, KKIV Corps on the right. Each Corps will land with divisions abreast.
 - (4) One Tenth Army Reserve division willflint a landing On the southeastern shore of CANAL on L and L plus 1 mays.
 - (5) Following the landing, the capture of OKINAM IS south of the ISHIKAM ISTUMUS.
 - (b) Phase II
 Solzure of IE SMIN, occupation of such portion of norther OKINAL as necessary to establish control of the entire island, and development of additional base facilities in favorable localities.
 - (c) Phase III
 Exploitation of our position in the N.NSEI SHOTO, soizing and developing additional islands of the group.

(4) III Phib Corps, composed of lat and 6th IPr Divs lands on Boaches north of HIGUSHI, secures airfield south of ZIOHIM, protects the left (north) flank of the operation.

(5) 77th Inf Div (Reinf) sweeps through KERUE Not Coud KEISE SHIM clearing hostile forces therefrom. Lands too 150mm gun battalions

(6) 2d Mar Div (Reinf) conducts foint landing on southeast coast of OXITIM IS on Land L / Days.

(7) 27th Inf Div (Reinf) in Army Reserve prepared to execute any of the Army Reserve plans.

(8) 81st Inf Div (Roinf), at YEN CLLEDOMA, in Lica Reserva.

- (9) XXIV Corps, composed of 7th and 96th Inf Divs lands on Boaches PURPLE, OR. TGE, THITE and BROWN, south of HAGUSHI on OKINATA IS, secures the K.DEM Airfield, protects the right (south) flank of the operation.
- (10) 7th Inf Div (Reinf), lands Boaches PURPLE and CRINGE, secures KIDEM Airfield, is to be prepared to continuo the attack to the south along the east coast of OKINAM IS.

(11) 96th Inf Div (Roinf) (-382d Inf Ronf), lands Baaches THITE and ERCIN advances inland seizes commanding ground in its zone of action,

protects the Corps right (south) flank.

- (12) RCT 381 lands at H-Hour on L Day on MHITE Boaches with two (2)

 Bus abroast advances rapidly inland removes enemy morter and small

 arms fire from its beaches, captures commanding hills along the

 line SUMBE-SUKURAMAHILL 102.
- (15) RCT 385 lands at H-Hour on L Day with two Bns abroast on BROWN Beaches, advances rapidly inland, removes enemy mortar and small arms fire from its beaches, seizes the high ground in its zone of action.
- (14) 582d Inf (Reinf), in Corps Reserve affect, will be prepared to land at approximately 1200 I on L Day behind 7th or 96th Inf Divs to assist in the execution of the Corps mission.
- (15) 780th Amph Tk Bn procedes tractor waves, advances inland through scawall in direct support of RCTs, serving as artillery. If the seawall cannot be crossed, swings to the flanks and supports the advance from positions on the reef or beach in the intervals between beaches.
- (16)L Day 1 April 1945 (tentative), H-Hour to be announced (tentatively, 0830 I)

2. The 728th Amphibian Tractor Bn will:

- a. At H-Hour on L-Day transport two assault BLTs of ROT 381 landing on MHITE Boaches.
- b. Rally at soa, transfor and land Roo BLT of ROT 381 on WRITE Boaches.
- c. Bo propored to:

(1) Transfor and land Ros ROT on WHITE Beaches.

(2) Engage in Ship to Shore lighterage under SP control.

3. a. Company A, 728th Amphibian Tractor Battalion will:
(1) At M-Hour on L-Day transport BLT 381/1, landing on Beaches MHITE 2

(2) Rally at sea, furnish waves 1 and 2 for trans or of Res BLT 381/2 from boats to Lyms landing on Beaches MMITE 2 and WHITE 3 on RCT order.

(3) Be prepared to:

- (a) Furnish waves 1 and 2 for transfer of RCT 382 landing on Beach SHITE 2 and WHITE 3.
- (b) Engage in Ship to Shore lighterage on Bn order.

b. Company B. 728th Amphibian Tractor Battalion will:

(1) At H-Hour on L-Day transport BLT 381/3, landing on Beach MHITE 1.
(2) Rally at sea, furnish waves 3,4 and 5 for transfer of Res BLT 381/2 from boats to LVTs landing on Beaches WHITE 2 and WHITE 3 on RCT order.

(3) Be prepared to:

- (a) Furnish waves 3,4 and 5 for transfer of ROT 382 landing on .
 Beaches MMITT 2 and MMITE 3.
- (b) Engage in Ship to Shore lighterage on Bn order.
- c. Maintenance Section, 728th Amphibian Tractor Bn will follow 6th assault wave to transfer line, then move to Rally Area pending further instructions.
- d. Medical Detachment, 728th Amphibian Tractor Bn will move directly to Rally Area propared to land on designated beach on order and establish forward Bn Aid Station.
- x. (1) This order is offective upon receipt. In the event it is rescinded and FO 1 BLKER is to be placed in offect, message order will be issued stating "Execute FO 1 BLKER".
 - (2) Elements on flanks of units temporarily held up by hostile resistance will not wait for the delayed unit, but will continue the assault giving every assistance to the delayed unit by outflanking the resistance and by fire. LYTS will not fire over friendly troops while waterborns.
 - (3) All commanders will insure adequate preparation of defenses against night counterattack. Particular attention will be paid to coordination of supporting night fires.
 - (4) All dommanders will insure that adequate local defenses are setablished by all installations and command posts and that every Officer and enlisted man has a definitely assigned position and mission in case of attack. Only under extreme emergencies will combat troops be employed for direct defense of such installations.
 - (5) ill units will organize their cross for defense against airborne attack to include a complete and speedy warning system, assignment of units to a definite area of local responsibility, and designation of reserves capable of quick movement.
 - (6) Tractor Bns will be utilized for totical or supply missions only in connection with ascault operations or shore party activities calboach defense.

(7) Neodless destruction of friendly airplanes by indiscriminate fire has occurred in previous operations. Controlled units will fire only when cleared by proper control or whom directly attacked, and no other individual or unit will fire about sircraft except when direct attack. During hours of darkness, controlled AMA units only will fire at any aircraft, and then only under proper clearance.

(8) commanders of all units will be held strictly responsible for the olimination of uncontrolled and indiscriminate firing by our own troops, and beginning with the initial landing will take such drastic measures as may be necessary to that end. All test firing will be supervised and conducted between 1200 and 1300. This organization will not test fire.

(9) Joint Army-May command relations during the amphibious phase of the operation are normal. For ship to shore operations Maval Commanders exercise command of the landing force through the

appropriate irmy Commanders;

(10) As far as practicable, all tracked vehicles, particulary tanks and LVTS will stay off existing roads and tails and move cross-country paralleling existing roads.

(11) On L-Day offensive operations generally will coase at 1700 (1 hr. 45 min before sunset). On L plus 1 Day the advance will be resumed

at0800 (1 hr 39 mins after sunrise).

(12) Road blocks in dopth will be maintained in rear areas as may be needed for adequate protection.

- (13) Rally iroas at soa are in intervals between Beaches WHITE 1 and 2 as shown on OPERABIOUS IMP ADDRESS ABLES
- (14) Bn 5-3 aboard TransDiv 40 Control Boot.

(15) Bn S-4 with CO 170th Engr Bn as Ln O. (16) Bn S-1 with Boachmaster Boach MHITE 1 as Ln O.

(17) Hq Sv C.O. with Boachmaster Boach MHITE 3 as In O.

(18) Ship to Shore Movement Plan Annox OHIRLIE
