F. Results of operations A Co. - Heavy enemy arty fire on pltns all day. One shrapnel casualty. 1st pltn fired 6 rds on enemy OP. 2nd pltn 10 rds on OP. 3rd pltn moved from Chaufontaine to firing position at Moncel at 2000. 1st Rcn pltn reconn. Moncel for positions under heavy arty fire then moved to 3rd pltn position. B Co. 2nd Rcn pltn reconn. left flank of CT3 to Herimenil (0997) and the right flank with no enemy contact. 2nd & 3rd pltns saw no action. 1st pltn fired at targets of opportunity from 1130 to 1830. Targets were at extreme range (4000 to 5000 yards) and consisted of tank, half-tracks and GP vehicles. None were destroyed certain. However the fire prevented enemy vehicles from attacking the Inf. or bridgehead. C Co. moved to Geberviller and occupied firing positions previously selected at 1100. CP in town square. At 1330 Co. moved to V079968 vic of Herimenil arriving at 1525. Recon. positions in Luneville. At 1830 1st pltn went into position at V095999. 3rd Rcn pltn with 1st pltn. No action. 2nd & 3rd pltns reserve with Co. at Co. CP. Extreme activity of enemy arty & mortar firing all night.

Results of operations A Co. at 1000 hrs 3rd pltn KO'd one Mkr IV at Moncel while under arty fire and isolated by German Inf. 1st pltn under arty fire all day; exp 20 rds HE at enemy OP & Inf CP 075984. B Co. in support of CT4 in attack on bridgehead over Meurthe river (132945). 1st pltn moved under fire at 0545 to 126948. At 1900 they moved again and covered ford. 1st sec, 1st pltn held position (125934) overlooking entire bridgehead operations and performed excellently, firing on tanks and enemy emplacements at ranges up to 5000 yards. 2nd sec, 1st pltn covered construction of bridge. 2nd pltn remained in position of readiness. 3rd pltn moved at 1450 to cover friendly tanks as they tried to ford river. They performed excellent support fire on enemy MG nests. At 2100 they moved into position covering road and RR to NW. C Co. - 2nd pltn committed at 0715 on E edge of Luneville. CP & 3rd pltn moved at 1155 to Chaufontaine (V074978). 3rd pltn alerted at 1530. 2 casualties inflicted by shrapnel while endeavoring to flush enemy snipers by carbine fire. At 1st pltn positions 3" firing was withheld for security of M10 positions. Continued shelling of Luneville by enemy.

F. Results of operations A Co. at 0800 2nd pltn moved from Luneville to Moncel in support of 3rd pltn. At 1230 Lt. J. Snider (2nd pltn ldr) was seriously wounded and Lt. D.G. Reck assumed charge. At 1800 the 3rd pltn moved to 122969 with the 1st Rcn pltn. 1st pltn no change. Again all pltns were subject to heavy arty fire. B Co. As bridgehead over the Meurthe river NE of Frambois was secured and passed the following wreckage was identified as being KO'd within the last two days. One bicycle and rider Two MG nests and one American M8 car employed as assault gun by the enemy. 1st pltn at 1300 fired 50 cal MG fire into the woods at 144947 and Inf was able to retake wood after having been driven out by enemy. 1st pltn fired into 3 buildings at St. Clement, directed at enemy tank and adjusted by FA plane. Succeeded in getting one hit and causing tank to leave hurriedly. At 1700 positions were taken to protect bridgehead. C Co. no change except much enemy arty fire and mortar fire was spasmodically directed at present.





A Co. Between 0800 and 1000 3rd pltn received some arty fire. At 1200 all pltns went into firing positions for indirect fire at 121021. Fire was commenced at 1400 and concentrations were fired every 20 minutes. No counter-battery was received. B Co. No action. No changes. No casualties. C Co. Pltns still in same approximate position. Enemy arty continued. 3rd Rcn pltn established listening posts on road in advance of 2nd pltn positions.
