


## 2<sup>ND</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE 773<sup>RD</sup> TD BN.

### HISTORY OF THE 773RD T. D. BATTALION



HE history of the battalion...begins with the induction into Federal Service...January 13, 1941, of the 141st Field Artillery Regiment (Louisiana National Guard).....the 166th Field Artillery Regiment (Pennsylvania National Guard). These units formed the 73rd Field Artillery Brigade....which was stationed at Camp Shelby, Mississippi.

In August of the same year....G and H Battery of the 141st FA; G and H Battery of the 166th FA, ..were combined with personnel of the Regimental Hq's Btry of the 190th FA...



and personnel of the Battalion Headquarters Batteries of the 141st FA. . .and the 166th FA Regiments.. and called the 73rd. Provisional Anti Tank Battalion. It was in this capacity.... that the battalion served through the Louisiana and Carolina Maneuvers, during which it traveled 9,500 miles through seven states, over a period of four months.

On December 15th, 1941, the 73rd was reorganized and became the 773rd TD Bn....one of the first TD Bns in the U.S.

After very extensive training at Camp Shelby, it was transferred on April 15 to Camp Young, California and was one of the initial units of the Desert Training Center. While at the DTC this unit was under General George Patton.

From the control of the Desert Training Center, the 773rd went to the Control of the Advanced Unit Training at Camp Hood, Texas on December 15, 1942 and remained under the AUTC control... until it left for Camp Atterbury, Ind. on April 12, 1943.

From Camp Atterbury...the 773rd passed to the control of the 2nd Army for the maneuvers in Tennessee...during which time it covered itself with glory. After eight weeks of maneuvers....the BN returned to Camp Atterbury..under the 9th Group and the IV Armored Corps.

The Organization's Colors were presented to them on October 1, 1943 and it is believed, that this was the first time any Tank Destroyer Colors..were presented to a TD Battalion in the U.S.

Benjamin Franklin chose the band of circles for his own coat of arms and we inherited them from the Pennsylva-


In thirty two months, the BN has taken an active part in four field maneuvers spent fifteen of the thirty two months in the field, and has covered eighteen states from coast to coast. Commendations on its work..have been received from the Commanding Generals....of the First, Second and Third Armies the VII Corps and the 17th Combat Team.

The 704 enlisted men in the BN represent 47 states and the 40 officers... represent 18 states. Many of the men speak two or more languages; Armenian, Greek, Hungarian, Syrian, Slovenian, and Lithuanian are a few of the 25 different tongues.

During recent months..136 men have left the unit to attend various OCS. Some time ago five gun crews were selected to serve with the Army Transport Service. The BN is proud of its record... and is looking forward to greater and illustrious achievements in the future.




....and that boy was Frank G. Spioss.


He was transferred in September '39 to the 141st F.A. and there pioneered into the art of Anti-tank defenses.
