




SCHEDULED COMPLEMENTARY AIRPORT SHUTTLE

LOCAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Personnel coming in on US. 501 should take Veterans Hwy. 22, called the Conway bypass and Myrtle Beach near Aynor and go to Hwy. 17, then go south to Myrtle Beach and follow the map in your packet to the Ocean Forest Plaza.

Personnel coming in on US. 378 to Conway stay US. 378 until you get to Veterans hwy. go east until you get US. 17 and south to Myrtle Beach and follow the map in your packet.

Personnel coming from the north down I- 95 should take US- 40 Exit 81 B East to Wilmington, NC, just south of Smithfield, NC, and go east to US, 17 then go south to Myrtle Beach and follow the map in your packet.

Personnel coming from the south on US.-17 go to 48th Ave. in Myrtle Beach and go right to Ocean Blvd. go left about a mile and the Ocean Forest Plaza is on the left.
