SUBJECT: Action Against Enemy, Reports After/After Action Reports.

TO : THE ADJUTANT GENERAL, Washington, D.C.

1. In compliance with paragraph 10 (C3) AR 345-105, and Letter, Hqs 83rd Infantry Division, APO #83, U.S. Army, dated 20 July 1944, subject and file as above, the following report and information for the month of June 1944 is submitted:

(a) Operations of the 802d Tank Destroyer Battalion, for the month of June 1944, consisted of Unit and individual training and preparation in general for movement from the United Kingdom to an overseas destination. At 2235 hours 29 June 1944, the main body of this Unit embarked from the United Kingdom and disembarked on the Coast of France at 1135 hours 1 July 1944.

(b) The 802d Tank Destroyer Battalion, during the month of June 1944, did not have any occasion to contact any of the enemy's forces in combat.
