- 1744 - 1944 - Co's radio reconnaissance, contacted Co's 211 and 212 in Nagas.
- 1815 - Co's departed Augy area.
- 2044 - Co's serious illness.
- 2344 - C reported closed in assembly.
- 2444 - B reported 3 pistons in position, one in assembly.

- 0044 - Run 2 moved out to find front lines.
  - 0144 - Remainder of C's group arrived at adv 3. 7092603.
  - Hour Section and transportation closed in assembly at 1832000Z.
  - B-3 in firing position.
  - 0244 - In C 2 reports in - A relieved from 30th Div, attached 10th Pz Div.
  - 0344 - Co B was able to make significant forward.
  - 1044 - Estimated time of arrival invasion beaches had been made up of to have about 0.5h.
  - 1344 - In C 2 and A - A returned, having visited all reported locations of Corp and 10th Div, but failed to find them. In C departed with new location.
  - 2144 - In C arrived at the location given which was being vacated; new location determined.
  - 1455 - In answer to radio request, received location of VI Corps arty C.
  - 1544 - In C 2 departed a second time.
  - 1644 - In C 2 discovered Corp arty.
  - 1644 - VI Corps arty corrected location.
  - 1744 - In C found Corp arty.
- Plans are being made; no change likely tonight. No knowledge whether or not A returns to in. A is reported that USA has made considerable progress against M's operations. 30th Div along southeast, up. Infantry is exhausted.
- 2344 - In C 2 reports 10th Div says follow advance as closely as possible; become less in morning; move on your own initiative.

- 0044 - Run departed to select area 124701.
- 0044 - In C 2 reports: clearance required. In C follows Run.
- 1044 - In C orders in to 124701.
- 1144 - In C 2 reports: cannot move; blocked in. C. In C radioed he was going to Civitavecchia with run 1. Thereafter radio contact lost.
- 1144 - C 130th Inf in Civitavecchia reports no contact except stragglers.
- 1344 - In C, 3 miles N of Civitavecchia found and moving without opposition; returned.
- 1544 - All troops ordered out of Run area; C-2 departed on reconnaissance.
- 1944 - In closed in assembly; B & C at 670-690, C at 701-630.

- 0044 - In C ordered to VI Corps arty.
- 0744 - In ordered to assembly area between Civitavecchia and Tarquinia; In C departed with Co representatives.
- 0944 - In C 2 reports: no clearance tonight possibly.
- 1244 - In C returned from Fifth Army with information that A would be released to in.
- 1244 - Issued orders to A to get clearance from 1st Div and move to 700.

- 0744 - A guide met A at 700 and led them to 690-613 clearing at 0744.
- 1644 - 10th Fifth Army releases in from at contacts; in reports to army. He was ordered to select and move to a training area and await word of F-70's pending approval of a radio request to Hqs. for authority to reorganize on 2/0 18-25.

- 10 Accommodation made for training area.
- 11 Nothing to report.
- 12 In view of the considerable loss of the individual files west of base south of 1. The village was visited and houses to move out of the base around base. One toward base to receive 1-70s there.
- 13 In C was not expected to bring any weapons area near base line, as of position. However, returned 200 and 250.
- 14 & 15 Nothing to report.
- 16 1/3/61 - moved in advance 1 mile of Petronilla.
- 17 Received 29 1-100s, formerly 1-70s.
- 18 Paratrooper and driver training initiated.
- 19 Moved in base -5 to set up.
- 20 Nothing to report.
- 21 Received 3 more 1-100s. 1/3/61 were attached to 1st Corps and re-attached to 35th Div.
- 22 Moved training so could proceed.
- 23 Mr. Andrews, a flight instructor, all individual instructor, included.
- 24 Nothing to report.
- 25 15 miles, 1/3/61 of 1-100s, arrived to base 1-100s.
- 26 & 27 Nothing to report.
- 28 35th Div entered 2 TPs with crew attached to each in 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, 27th, 28th, 29th, 30th, 31st, 32nd, 33rd, 34th, 35th, 36th, 37th, 38th, 39th, 40th, 41st, 42nd, 43rd, 44th, 45th, 46th, 47th, 48th, 49th, 50th, 51st, 52nd, 53rd, 54th, 55th, 56th, 57th, 58th, 59th, 60th, 61st, 62nd, 63rd, 64th, 65th, 66th, 67th, 68th, 69th, 70th, 71st, 72nd, 73rd, 74th, 75th, 76th, 77th, 78th, 79th, 80th, 81st, 82nd, 83rd, 84th, 85th, 86th, 87th, 88th, 89th, 90th, 91st, 92nd, 93rd, 94th, 95th, 96th, 97th, 98th, 99th, 100th.
- 29 In C flew to Fifth Army. 1-100s will be loaned to 1st. The other 1-100s equipment will be sent, pending receipt of authority for change. From 1-3; 1-100s are not considered operationally fit.
- 30 In C visited 230 and 239 Div. The H-100 will not be used in any kind of training before morning 2 only, when they will be shown to 1-100s during one day week.
