HATTATIVE ACCOUNT OF BATTALLES OFFICE STATIONS

At the beginning of the month the Battelian CP was at DEMERINGE, France (9600 385). The rear echelon was at WALDAUMCH (9619 365).

On the 1st of Harch, "A" Company CP was at ST LOUIS, France (QYIA 132) and the disposition of the platoons were as follows - In the lat platoon, one gun was South of Mrishittal (4726 399) in AT defense posttion and three guns were in indirect fire positions at WATTERDEN (Q665 434). One section of the 2nd platoon was in the South part of the toen of Later and (9740 446) in AT defense position and the 2nd section was in the north part of LaBirC (4764 457) covering roads and tank approaches from BITCHE and R.Y. SWILL R. The 3rd plateon had one gan at the South and of CO. TELLIB AICK (4738 LLL) covering the read. One seetion was situated in the North of Skull Reports (4743 419). One gun of the 3rd platoon was in ordnance. For the period's operation, 2 game of the 1st platoon fired 21 indirect harassing siscions expending 6 rounds of smoke and 105 rounds of HE. The belance of the company maintained AT defense positions. The 3rd gun of the 2nd plateon received a direct hit by enorg morter fire. The gun was quickly repaired and ready for action by the end of the period. There were no casualties from tide enemy astion.
