ORDERS OF THE GUARD

(1) Personnel on the Guard will:

- a. Consistent with the available supply of clothing and equipment, present a smart appearance and conduct themselves in a most military manner, thereby reflecting credit upon the Armed Forces of the United States and the Philippine Commonwealth.
- b. Constantly police their areas and maintain sanitary conditions in the immediate vicinity of their posts.
- c. Keep all undergrowth in the vicinity of their posts cleared away to facilitate observation and prevent the enemy from infiltrating their positions and surprising the guard.
- d. Be constantly on the alert to destroy any enemy forces on or near their posts and prevent damage to any property it is their duty to guard.
- e. Be especially watchful at night.
- f. Where necessary, assist the military police in controlling traffic in the vicinity of the bridges they are guarding.
- g. Not permit civilians or other personnel to loiter on their posts and may mingle with the local population only when off duty.
