1. Enemy Action and Countermeasures

a. At 1130 9 June - Patrol near 0828.0-1922.0 received report from civilians that ten Japs were in the vicinity of SAN ANTONIO (0832.0-1919.5) and reinforcements were urgently needed. 632nd TD Bn was notified and a patrol of one tractor and 38 men joined 632's patrol at SAN ANTONIO. Area was searched - enemy fire was received - area was again searched. One Jap was wounded but could not be found. 826th patrol returned to Base Camp. 632nd TD was notified. Inclosed document was found.
