- 2 A Co - Lt NARA & Officer from 43rd Div, (plus 30 laborers, to supplement A Co pers) preparing for gasoline haul mission, departed 0730.
- 3 Lt DETZLER checked Base M guard posts.
- 4 Capt ADAMS
- 5 Co A CO, informed that 25 guerillas would supplement his pers for fuel dump guard. Later informed by Capt GERON, that number to be under his command would be 50 guerillas.
- 6 Gas hauling mission accomplished, vehicles returned to this area.
- 7 Maj JOHNSON, 720th MP's, phone Capt ADAMS, emphasizing importance of danger of sabotage at Alacan.

 reinforced with twenty (20) colored troops. No contact
