- 5. Advise Commanding Generals, Ninth Service Command, Army Service Forces, and Desert Training Center, of strength, dates of departure, mode of travel, and expected date and hour of arrival of all elements. Direct

communication, consistent with the RESTRICTED classification of this order, is authorized between interested commanders. Commanders concerned will report departures and arrivals to this headquarters by telegraph or telephone.

- 6. Only Tables of Basic Allowances equipment on hand will be taken.
- 7. Upon arrival at destinations these units are relieved from their present assignments and are reassigned as indicated:
