Post # 3. (25th St. and "A" St. on "A" St., to 24th St. South on 24th St. to South end of Battalion Motor Area.)

To allow no one except authorized persons to enter Motor Park and to be especially watchful of building # 3643, to be especially watchful of Battalion gasoline station and to be especially watchful for fires.

Post # 4. (25th and "A" Sts., south on 25th St. to South end of Battalion Motor Area then West along South end of Battalion Motor Area to 24th St.)

1. The guard will be composed of the Officer of the Day, one(1) sergeant (Commander of the guard) three (3) corporals, and eighteen (18) Privates. The complete guard, with the exception of the Officer of the Day, will be furnished by one Company daily. All members of the guard will be equipped with flashlights.

TwoFour of guard will be for twenty-four (24) hours from 1800 o'clock until 1800 o'clock the following day. Between 0600 and 1800 o'clock daily, posts 1, 2, & 3 will walk guard on posts 4, 5, & 6 respectively, in addition to the regular sentinels on these posts. Between the hours of 0800 and 1600 the sergeant and corporals of the guard will be charged with instructing the privates of the guard, who are not walking post, in interior guard duty for a minimum of two hours daily.

3. The new OD will inspect the new guard at 1700 o'clock daily in rear of battalion headquarters. Any man not passing inspection will be relieved and replaced before guard mount.

4. Informal guard mount will be held daily at 1800 o'clock at battalion guard house. Old and new OD's will report to the Commanding Officer, Executive or the Adjutant at battalion headquarters at 1830 o'clock daily.

5. Weekly guard memorandum will be published by this headquarters each Saturday detailing OD's and companies to furnish guard for the following week.

6. Cots, mattresses and bedding will be furnished by each individual guard for his own use.

7. Lights in the Battalion Area will be turned out according to the following schedule:

11. The Battalion OD will make frequent tour of the Battalion Area, using a Ford 1/2 Ton truck, prior to 2400 in order to apprehend any violators of Battalion rules. No other individual will be allowed the use of this vehicle.

12. The corporal of the old relief and the corporal of the new relief will march the new relief to their post and personally point out the limits of the post to each individual guard. Each fire phone near the post will be pointed out and instructions given as to proper use.

13. There will be a total of twelve inspections of the guard each night. The OD will inspect once before 2400 and once before reveille; the sergeant of the guard will inspect twice before 2400 and twice before reveille; and the corporal of each relief will inspect once during each tour of duty and at a time other than when the guard is being posted or relieved.

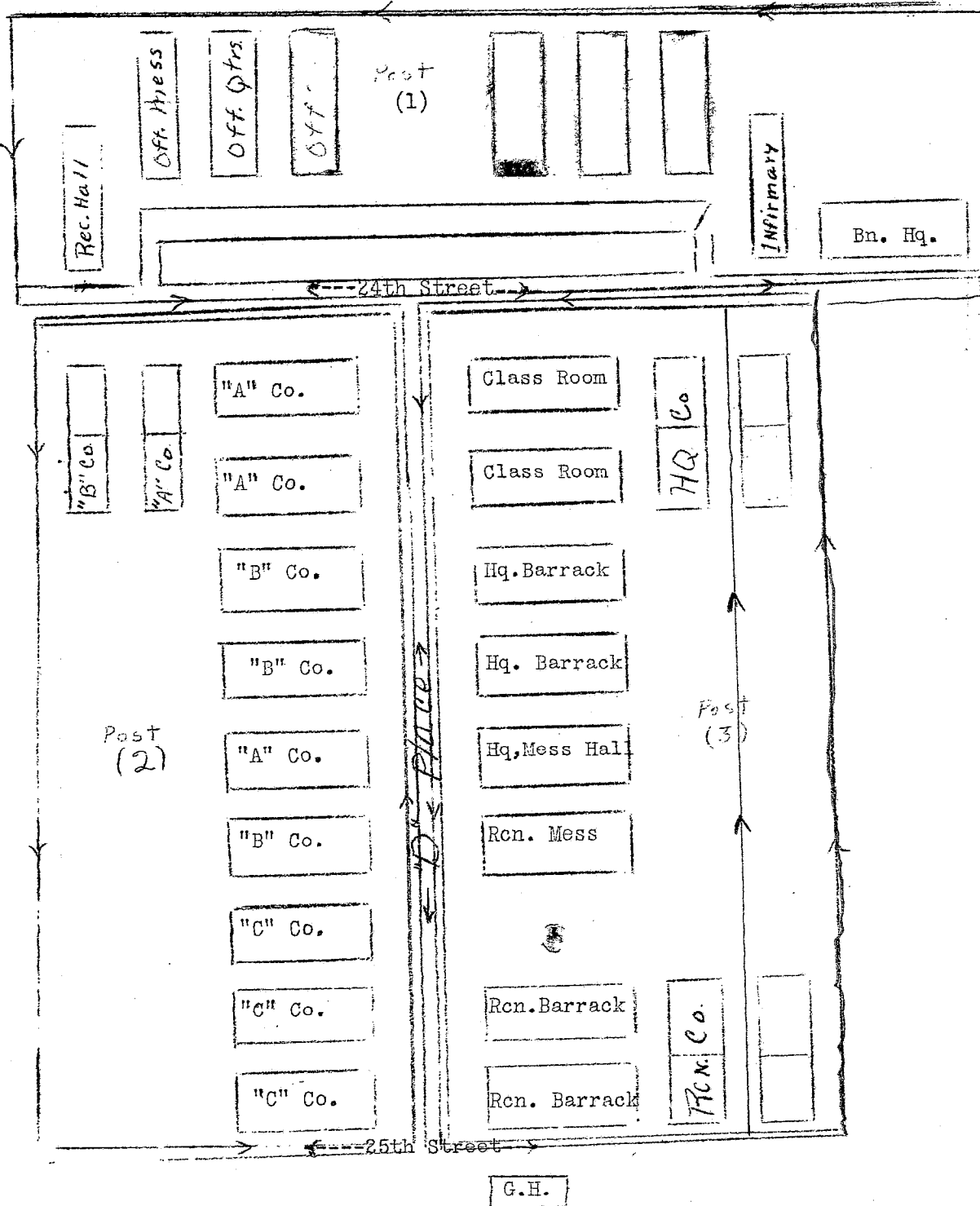

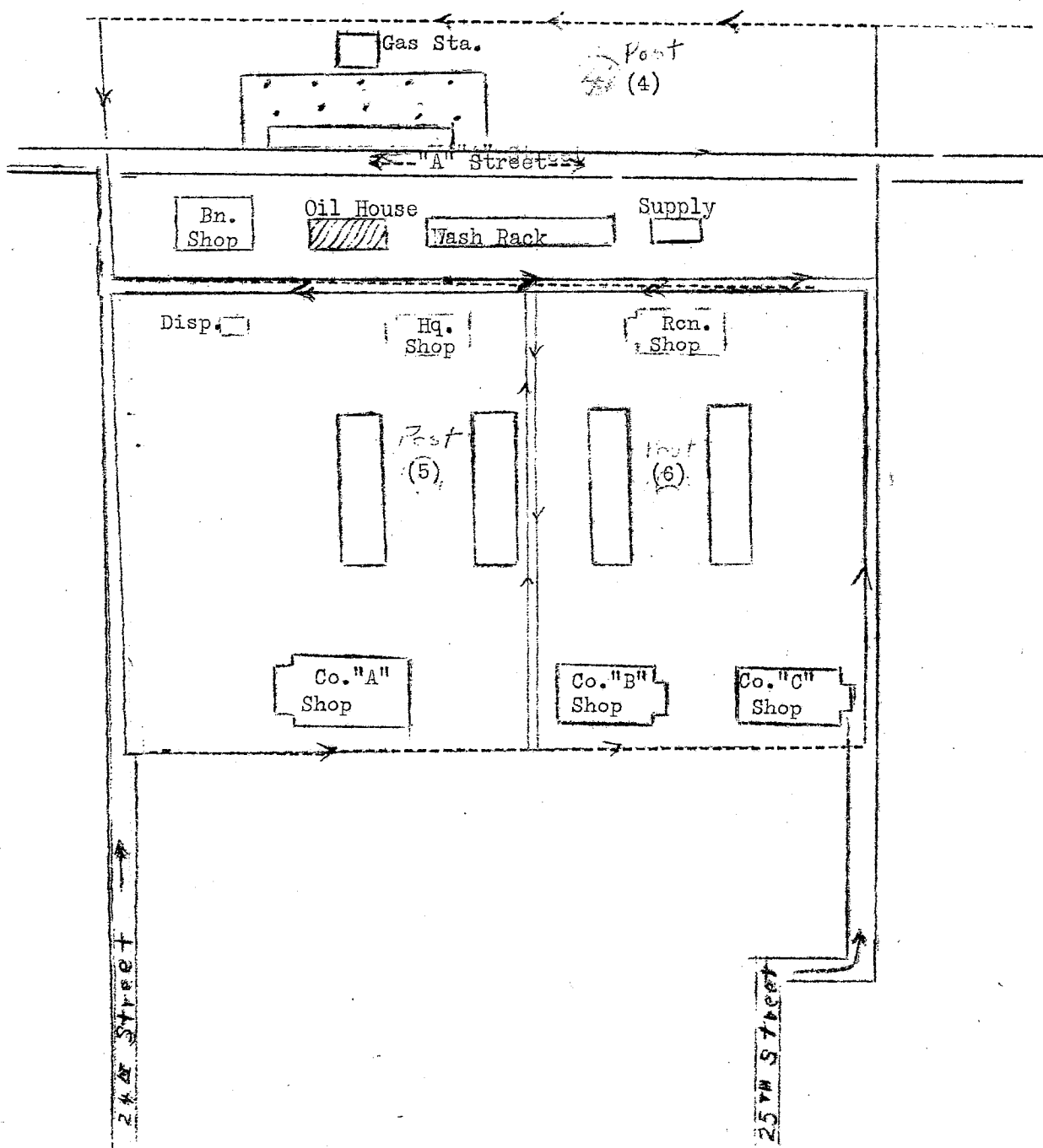

SUPPLEMENT TO GENERAL ORDERS # 14 HDORS, 829TH T. D. BATTALION

1. Effective immediately all sentinels will walk post armed with the rifle, Cal .22, complete with sling, less peep sight.
2. These rifles will be issued to the guard on memorandum receipt by the companies as follows: Hq Co.- 4; "A" Co.-4; "B" Co. -4; "C" Co.-3; Roc Co.-3; total 18 rifles.
3. These rifles will remain with the guard until further notice.
4. Each Officer of the Day will turn over to the new Officer of the day all guard property, including the rifles, after they have jointly inspected them.
5. Each Sergeant of the Guard will issue rifles to sentinels by number and sentinels will be charged with the care and cleaning of these rifles. The Officer of the Day will arrange for necessary cleaning materials to be placed in the guard house and will improvised cleaning rods from heavy wire or some such material.
6. Sentinels must be thoroughly instructed in the manual of the rifle before going on post. See FM 26-5, Interior Guard Duty.
7. Prescribed uniform for the Guard: Wool O. D. with service coat, leggins, and raincoat neatly folded under belt in back. The O. D. will prescribe when overcoats and overshoes will be worn. The jacket will not be worn at any time by any member of the guard.

UNIT FIRE REGULATIONS - 829TH TANK DESTROYER BATTALION

1. Company commanders are responsible that the provisions of General Orders No. 15, Headquarters, Camp Gruber, Oklahoma, and supplements thereto, which are attached and made a part of these regulations; are rigidly carried out.

2. Each company is charged with the protection of all buildings under its immediate supervision including the motor shop and park. Headquarters Company will be responsible for the Battalion Motor Shop, Oil and Grease Houses, Battalion Supply, the Gasoline Pumps, and the two classrooms; "B" Company's area will include the Battalion Recreation Hall, Officers Mess and Battalion Officers Quarters; Reconnaissance Company's area will include the Guard House and the Medical Detachment will make arrangements for the protection of the Dispensary and Battalion Headquarters.

3. Each company will organize and train the following fire details:

- 2 Guard Details - - - - - 1 NCO and 7 men
- 2 Salvage Details - - - - - 2 NCO's and 14 men - Fire axes
- 2 Chemical Details - - - - - 1 NCO and 7 men ( All available fire extinguishers )
- 2 Fire-fighting Details - - - - - 4 NCO's and 30 men ( Axes, picks, shovels, buckets, etc. )

One of each of the above details must be on the alert at all times.

In case of fire anywhere in the fire zone # 5 all companies will fall out in front of their individual barracks, and will stand by, alerted, until relieved or ordered to the site of the fire by this headquarters.

In case of fire in the Battalion Area, all companies will follow the same procedure except the company immediately concerned. This Company will report to the fire with its alert details and fight the fire until relieved by the Fire Chief or the Camp Fire Marshal.

4. Fire Drills will be held monthly on orders of the Battalion Commander.

5. Company Commanders will instruct all personnel in their duties, location of fire extinguishers, location and use of fire phones and location of fire escapes. They will also make weekly inspections of all fire extinguishers and fire hazards.

6. Major E. J. McCormick is designated as Assistant Fire Marshal for this organization.

7. Each company will have placed in the orderly room, (iron pipe) to be used by the Charge of Quarters to sound as a fire alarm upon discovery of a fire in the area or upon being advised of a fire or fire drill by telephone or other means. The alarm will be sounded in such manner that all members of the company will hear it.
