How is everything back home? I sure I hope. I still haven't gotten any mail lately! I am just about to give up writing as I don't get any mail in return. I have been out on 2 weeks of battle training and just got back at 4 o'clock this afternoon and it is now 7. I came back to find the company had finally moved to Bad Aibling. It is a nice place here, a heck of a lot better than the hole we just left. The two weeks of battle training wasn't hard, but you couldn't get mail out or in and we had to eat K rations most of the time. On the way back from the battle training area (which is about 100 miles from here) we came thru Munich, Ger. and ate a good hot meal and got PX rations and I got a nice Schleggers pencil for a dollar & sixty cents and it is a honey. I am using it now. Well, so long for a while & write soon. D
