





SUBJECT: Operation of Information and Historical Services

Commanding Generals: Each Army Group Each Army

- 1. Letter, this headquarters, file AG 312.1 OpHIST, subject: "Handling of Historical Documents in the European Theater of Operations," dated 14 July 1944, and letter, this headquarters, file and subject as above, dated 15 March 1945, are
- 2. Information and Historical Services have been assigned to each army in the theater and charged with securing historical information and materials to serve as the basis for the preparation of an official history of theater operations. In order that the activities of all units may receive full and accurate treatment in the final official history, it is necessary that personnel of Information and Historical Services receive the fullest cooperation from all commanders.
- 3. It is desired that Information and Historical Services be given access to key personnel and historical information of a classified nature at the level of command and decision within army, corps, and division headquarters. Such access will insure that a proper balance is maintained in the official history between tactical operations and command actions and responsibilities.
- 4. The preparation and submission of after-action reports and supporting documents as required by paragraph 10, Change 4, AR 345-105, is a responsibility of the commander concerned and is not a part of the mission of Information and Historical Services.
- 5. Reports after action will be submitted through command channels at the end of each month during which a unit is engaged. If operational demands necessitate delay, reports will be forwarded as soon as operational conditions permit. Reports will be forwarded in duplicate to this headquarters, together with one copy of supporting documents thereto.
- 6. After action reports will be a single, narrative account from the standpoint of the commander.
- 7. Special attention will be given by all organizations to insure that these reports include definite information concerning:
- a. The precise composition of special task forces, regimental combat teams, or combat commands. In the case of units lower than division, this should be interpreted in terms of important combat patrols, assault teams, etc.

- \underline{b} . An exact and descriptive statement of the objective in critical phases of operations. A definition of the objective is necessary to the meaning of the report.
- \underline{c} . In lower units, a census on casualties in the case of every important action, although casualty figures may already have been submitted through other channels.
 - d. Terrain and weather when these items affect the course of the action.
- . 8. Fragmentary and verbal field orders at all levels of command should be carefully recorded by the organization concerned and the substance of such orders included in the after action report or in the accompanying journals.
 - 9. Supporting documents will include:
 - a. Reports and journals of the staff section (both general and special).
- <u>b</u>. Reports and journals of combat units, including report of artillery and armored commanders, if available.
- C. Journal file, including messages and reports of teams such as IPW, OB, PI, and MII.
- d. Message files (telephone and radio messages may be covered by journal entries).
 - e. Periodic reports (with overlays).
- $\underline{\underline{f}}$. Sitreps, field orders, operations memoranda, letters of instruction, and staff memoranda.
- g. All specially prepared maps, sketches, overlays, and photographs, whether prepared for operational or historical purposes, including any standard maps not distributed by the army engineer.
- 10. Top secret documents will be submitted with after action reports as soon as they have been downgraded. This is particularly necessary in the case of operations instructions or letters of instructions.
- Il. Certain original documents used in the field have been reproduced in such a manner that the documents become illegible after a short period. Consistent with operational needs and urgency, it is essential that these important historical sources be in a form as permanent and enduring as may be possible.
- 12. Careful packaging and handling of acter action reports is essential. Reports and inclosures will be forwarded to this headquarters securely packaged and properly marked.
 - 13. The Theater Historian will continue to exercise technical supervision of

all historical work in the Communications Zone and field forces in this theater.

its drive down the IRRAWADDY RIVER in BURMA toward a junction with Allied forces north of RANGOON. More gains were made east of the railroad linking RANGOON and MANDALAY. In CHINA, Chinese forces captured three towns in the HONAN PROVINCE southeast of CHUNGKING. Supplies on 60 ships are being sent to the CHANGEL ISLANDS and King George has addressed a message to the British subjects there. Marchal Montgomery received a great ovation from the DESTARK citizens when he arrived in COPENHAGEN. It is announced that one—third of the area in the BRITISH ISLES was utilized for training of American pre-invasion forces.

614th TD's CITED

The Third Platoon, "C" Company, of the 614th Tank Destroyer Battalion was awarded the Presidential Unit Citation yesterday afternoon by Major General Anthony C. McAuliffe, commander of the 103 Infantry Division. The unit was cited for its actions on December 14, 1945, during the attack on Climbach, France. First two men to receive the badge were 1st/Sgt. Robert Cannon, platoon leader, and Sgt. Dillard L. Booker, highest ranking non-com left from the original platoon. General McAuliffe also presented Silver Stars to Capt. Walter S. Smith, 1st Lt. Serreo S. Nelson and 2nd Lt. Cristopher J. Sturkey during the ceremonies.

Vest Pocket Baedeker: Innsbruck

Chief point of interest in the Tirol section is Innsbruck, famous scenic resort city in the Austrian Alps. Located near the borders of Italy, Germany and Switzerland, Innsbruck's winter sports attracted tourists from all over Europe in pre-war days. Now having a normal population of 76,000, Insbruck developed from the little village of Hoetting, which still stands on the north side of the Inn River. Hoetting was started in the latter days of the Roman Empire, roughly estimated to be 80 A.D. Roman coins are infrequently found in this old town. The site became a crossway for commercial traffic and Innsbruck was declared a city in approximately 1200 A.D.

Using the street Maria Theresien, which is the main thoroughfare, as a focal point, spots of interest can be found in the
following manner: Going slightly northwest down Burg Graben, which
is a continuation of Markt Graben, one skirts the oldest part of the
city, leading directly into the Imperial Palace of the Habsburg line
of kings. From here, Friedrich Strasse leads through the center of
the old part of Innsbruck. The new University of Innsbruck is at
the junction of Innrain and Markt Graben while the old site, founded
in the fifteenth century, is near the junction of Burg Graben and
Universitaets Strasses.
