(Confirming Oral Orders)

1. a. Hns of 6th SS Mtn Div (estimated 3000-6000 men) started from (W6595), proceeded E, cut the Autobahn, proceeded farther E, taking a gas dump and a hospital, reached ORTENBERG (W9396), then proceeded SE. At last Hr (1630, 2 April) the 11st Div was Atkng this force from three sides in BUDINGER VALD (W0285) and apparently had the situation under control. Resistance on the front of 324th Inf has been light.

b. 11st Div Atkng in BUDINGER VALD. 106th Cav Co has advanced to outskirts of STEINHAU (W2492) and E of BAD ODE (W1552). 532d QM Bn 7th Inf Co (W117) Atchd 11th Inf Div. 217th FA Bn reverts to Div control.

2. Div moves 2 April E of MAIN R, prepared on Corps O to Adv N of line FRANZENSBACH (W2464) - FLOSTERN (W0456) and take over Z and mission of 45th Inf Div. Pz assembly areas, Bds and front lines see overlay.

3. a. 11st Inf:

Atchd: Co A, 772d Tk Bn
Co A, 776th TD Bn
Co A, 63d Regt Bn
Co A, 119th Med Bn
7709th FA Co (for movement only)

Move commencing 1430, 2 April, in accordance with previous instructions. Relieve Hns of 324th Inf on line shown, holding lightly on right and maintaining at least one Bn on line between (W0741) and BAUER (W0177). Hold BAUER and KUTZKAUSEN (W0274) strongly and high ground between the two. Maintain armor and reserve behind left Hns. Be prepared, if necessary, to defend or Atk to N, or, on O, to Atk to E and NE in Z. On arrival of 772d Tk Bn in Z's position, Co G thereof reverts to Bn control.

b. 324th Inf:

Co B, 776th TD Bn
Co C, 63d Regt Bn
Co C, 119th Med Bn

Upon being relieved by 11st Inf N of new Bd, reorganize prepared on O to Atk N and NE in Z.

1 Plat, Co B, 63d Regt Bn ~~MAIN R~~

Move 1 Bn, N63, Reinforced with 1 Plat Inf and 1 Plat TDC, to BAD ODE to secure the town and the captured PW camp.

Move Regt (-) to assembly area shown on overlay. Be prepared, if necessary, to attack to N. Prepare one Bn ADV RWD in Reserve. Push


W0458 Cluster Div Arty: Opt 324th and 11st Inf Regts, prepared to fire northward if necessary. Move 217th FA Bn to Opt 1 position East MAIN commencing 3 April.



1. Div (-) moves to assembly areas shown on overlay 16 April preparatory to training in river crossing operations.

2. CP 111 (- Arty):

Atchd: Co B, 772 Tk Bn

Move foot Elms by marching via Route C, passing IP at ENNACHSHOF (N5231) 1430 B, 16 April. For movement of motor Elms see march table.

3. CP 71:

See overlay and march table. Arrange with 772 Tk Bn and 776 TD Bn for transporting maximum personnel on T of those units. Make full use of Atchd Engrs and Arty for transporting personnel. Vehicles of 2d shuttle pass IP not earlier than 1915.

- a. a. Div CP opens new location 1430.
b. Units select and report CPs.

- x. (1) All installations, including CPs, will be established in the field.
(2) All vehicular movement north of highway ULTINGEN (N4334) - RJ (N50355) and south of 45 grid line will be blackout ("cat eyes" only).
(3) Appropriate AA measures, both active and passive, will be taken on march and in assembly area.
(4) Quartering parties by infiltration in groups of not more than 3. They will not break into march units.
(5) No vehicles larger than $\frac{1}{2}$ -ton truck will double-bank a Glm.
(6) Maintain 60-yard interval whether moving or halted.
