Know Ye, that reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity and abilities of **Claude Headen, Junior** *I do*
appoint him as a Reserve Commissioned Officer *in the*
Officers' Reserve Corps

Army of the United States
 in the grade of Captain

to date as such from the **twelfth** *day of* **November** *nineteen*
hundred and **fifty-two** *. This Officer will therefore carefully and diligently*
discharge the duties of the office to which appointed by doing and performing all
manner of things thereunto belonging.

And I do strictly charge and require these Officers and other personnel of lesser rank to render such obedience as is due an officer of this grade and position. And this Officer is to observe and follow such orders and directions from time to time as may be given by me, or the future President of the United States of America, or other Superior Officers acting in accordance with the laws of the United States of America.

This commission is to continue in force during the pleasure of the President of the United States of America, for the time being, under the provisions of those Public Laws relating to Officers of the Armed Forces of the United States of America and the component thereof in which this appointment is made.

Done at the City of Washington, this **twelfth** *day of* **November** *in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and* **fifty-two** *and of the*
Independence of the United States of America, the one hundred and **seventy-seventh**
