

Body of Local War Hero Is Reinterred

The body of PFC Edward A. Dabulas, son of Mrs. Jennie Dabulas, 602 Court Street, a casualty of World War II, was reinterred last

Thursday in the National Cemetery, Farmingdale, N. Y.

Private Dabulis, a former member of the Civilian Conservation Corps, enlisted in the Army on Sept. 2, 1942. He was wounded in action in Italy and awarded the Purple Heart. He subsequently returned to service and was wounded again in action in Southern France. He died on Aug. 22, 1944, of his wounds. A brother, Edward, served with the Army Air Force.

The deceased attended North Scranton Junior High School and played basketball with the Weston Field team. He was a member of St. Joseph's Church, North Scranton.

Private Dabulis also is survived by a brother, Joseph, at home, and four sisters, Genevieve and Joan, at home; Mrs. Matthew Ryan, New York City, and Mrs. Harold Golden, Dunmore.
