

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENLISTED RECORD

- Enter date of induction only in case of trainee inducted under Selective Training and Service Act of 1940 (Title 25, W in all other cases enter date of enlistment. Eliminate word not applicable).
- For each enlistment give company, regiment, or arm or service with inclusive dates of service, grade, cause of number of days lost under AW 107 (if none, so state), and number of days retained and cause of retention in service for of the Government, if any.
- Enter qualifications in arms, horsemanship, etc. Show the qualification, date thereof and number date, and source annotating same.
- See paragraph 12, AR 40-210.
- If discharged prior to expiration of service, give number, date, and source of order or full description of authority.
- Enter periods of active duty of enlisted men of the Regular Army Reserve and the Enlisted Reserve Corps and dates of Federal Service in the cases of members of the National Guard.
