

Killed In Action

Pfc. Robert C. Lucas, husband of the former Martha Thomas, of this city, was killed in action April 2, in Germany, according to information received by his wife Friday night. He had been previously reported missing as of April 2, in a telegram from the War Department, received Thursday morning.

Pfc. Lucas is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Chalmers Lucas, of Indiana. He entered the service in March, 1942 and left for overseas duty in September, 1944. He has been serving in France and Germany with a tank destroyer unit.

He is survived by his parents, his widow and 14-months-old son, two sisters, Mrs. Frank Lydick, of Erie; Mrs. Walter Hamilton, of Homer City, and two brothers, John and Dick, of Indiana.
