## CITATION

Destroyer Battalion, for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in Germany from 25 March to 14 April 1945. In the advance across Germany, Sergeant SCIULLI'S tank destroyer, of which he was commander, broke down in a small town in the vicinity of Hersfeld, Germany. The remainder of the Battalion was forced to move on ahead and the advance was so rapid that it was impossible to send back a retriever to bring him forward. With his crew of four (4) members and fifteen (15) Infantrymen who had been riding on the deck of the destroyer, he assumed control of the town and surrounding areas and had the able bodied civilians repair roads and remove partially destroyed road blocks. He maintained a very high degree of discipline and order which reflects the highest credit upon himself and the armed forces of the United States. Entered military service from Ohio.
