Subject: Historical Data

To : Commanding Officer, 607th TD Bn

1. On 13 September 1944 the 2d gun of the 1st Section 2d Platoon, Company C, 607th TD Bn fired 10 rounds of HE, 3 in. ammunition upon German soil.

2. The following is the pertinent data concerning the positions and personnel:

a. Gun position at 899-946, map scale 1/100,000, Sheet V2 Neunkirchen.

b. Target at 022-980, town of Perl, map scale 1/100,000 Sheet V2 Neunkirchen.

c. Time fired: - Commenced fire at 1823 and 10 seconds 13 September 1944, ceased fire at 1824 and 50 seconds 13 September 1944.
