Subject: Summary of Operations for June 1944.

Adjutant General, Washington, DC.

: Commanding General, 90th Infantry Division, APO 90, US Army.

1 - 13 June Training and preparation for short sea voyage at Barton Stacey, Hampshire, England.

9 June Company Commanders and Staff were briefed on pending operation by 9th Infantry Division Artillery.

14 June Battalion, less rear echelon, moved to marshaling area.

16 June Headquarters and "A" Company embarked at South Hampton, England.

17 June Headquarters and "A" Company disembarked at Utah Beach on Cherbourg Pennisula, France. Landing was with out incident. Moved to dewaterproofing area B at Ste Germain de Verraville, France. Dewaterproofed and moved up to support 9th Infantry Division's anti-tank defenses.

\$18 June

Moved CP to vicinity of Picard, France. Company "A", less one platoon, employed in vicinity of Canville, France to protect Division from attack from south and southwest. Company "A" captured one prisoner.

Res 19 June

CP moved to vicinity of Blandamour, France. Company "A" less one platoon, closed in assembly area near Blandamour, France. Battalion (less B & C. companies and rear echelon not yet joined) detached from 9th Infantry Division and VII Corps - attached to VIII Corps - Company "A" attached to 82d A/B Division - Battalion less Company "A" attached to 90th Infantry Division. (Effective for companies B

and rear echelon upon arrival).

CARCELE

-20 June Moved CP to vicinity of Ste Colombe. Company "A" joined 82d A/B Division, was emplaced to reimforce divisional DEC ? 1944 Willeston anti-tank defenses.

- 21 June CP moved to Cretteville, France.
- 22 23 June Reconnaissance and wire communications completed for employment of B and C Companies upon arrival in support of 90th Infantry Division Artillery.
  - 24 June Companies Bulland "C" landed and dewaterproofed vehicles in vicinity of SterGermain de Verraville. Company "B" attached to 357th Infantry by Division order. Proceeded to join that unit vicinity, Besneville, France. Company "C" moved to indirect fire-position vicinity Gretteville.
- 25 29 June Company "C" fired indirect fire on roads in enemy rear area. (23 K transfers & 80 map data corrected concentrations, total 1790 rounds.)
  - 130 "Fune Company" B" rejoined Battalton and occupied indirect fire positions.


