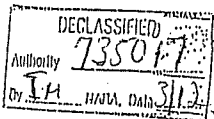

GENERAL ORDERS

1 July 1946

1. Except as hereinafter specifically ordered the interior guard will function as prescribed by FM 26-5.

2. GENERAL.

- a. Composition and strength of the Guard will be as prescribed in par 1 current annex of the Guard Orders.
- b. Not more than 50% of the privates of the guard not on patrol may be absent from the guard house at any one time.
- c. Equipment and uniform of the guard will be as prescribed in par 2 current annex to guard orders.

3. DUTIES OF PERSONNEL:

a. Officer of the Day.

- (1) He is responsible to the Commanding Officer for all action of the guard during his tour.
- (2) He will perform his duties as prescribed in Par 13 FM 26-5.
- (3) Current instructions of the OD are as prescribed in Par 3 current annex to the guard orders.

b. Sergeant of the Guard.

- (1) He is responsible to the Officer of the Day for the proper functioning of his guard.
- (2) He will perform his duties as prescribed in Par 15, FM 26-5.
- (3) Current instructions of the SG are as prescribed in Par 4 current annex to the guard orders.

c. Corporal of the Guard.

- (1) He is responsible to the Sgt of the Guard for the proper functioning of his relief.
- (2) He will perform his duties as prescribed in Par 16, FM 26-5.
- (3) Current instructions to the Corporal of the Guard are as prescribed in Par 5 of current annex to the Guard Orders.

d. Privates of the Guard.

- (1) Privates of the guard will perform duties as prescribed in Par 18, FM 26-5.
- (2) Current instructions to Privates of the Guard are as prescribed in Par 6, current annex to the Guard Orders.

4. FORMATIONS:

- a. Guard Mount will be held as prescribed in Par 3, Appendix I FM 26-5 at the time prescribed in Par 7 current annex to

Guard Orders. Variations of guard mount will be necessitated by guard composition.

- b. Guard may be turned out for inspection at the discretion of the C.O. or O.D.
- c. Reliefs will be formed and posted as prescribed in Par 24, FM 26-5, by responsible NCO.

5. ORDERS:

- a. General Orders as prescribed in par 26, FM 26-5 will be followed.
- b. Special Orders for posts will be as prescribed in Par 8 of current annex to Guard Orders.

INACTIVATION OF CERTAIN UNITS

1. Effective 1 November 1946, the following units will be inactivated at Camp Hood, Texas:

- 523th Field Artillery Battalion (155mm Gun, Comb Trk Dr and Sp)
- 3353d QM Gas-Supply Company
- \*614th Tank Destroyer Battalion (SP)  
(\*Negro Enlisted Personnel)

2. Personnel:

a. Officers: Officer personnel will be disposed of by separate instructions to be issued by this headquarters.

b. Enlisted Men:

- (1) No enlisted man will be reduced in grade as a direct result of any action ordered herein.
- (2) All non-regular Army enlisted personnel who are within six (6) months of attaining eligibility for separation will be separated under the provisions of paragraph 1a, TWX WCL 46706, 25 September 1946, as quoted in Letter AG 220.8 AKAAG-PE, Headquarters Fourth Army, 27 September 1946, Subject: "Discharge Criteria".
- (3) A complete roster of enlisted personnel not eligible for separation showing grade, name, Army serial number, Military Occupational Specialty, physical profile serial, whether POR or non-POR qualified and month and year of eligibility for separation will be submitted to this headquarters by units concerned at the earliest practicable date.
- (4) Enlisted personnel not eligible for separation will be disposed of by separate instructions to be issued by this headquarters.

3. Equipment:

a. Excess equipment will be disposed of in accordance with letter Headquarters, Army Ground Forces, 400.703/400 (11 Jan 46) GNGDS, 11 Jan 1946, Subject: "Disposition of Equipment", and 1st Indorsement thereto, Hq Fourth Army, 23 January 1946.

b. Separate detailed instructions will be issued by this headquarters to units concerned.

4. Funds:

a. Unit funds and fund properties will be disposed of in accordance with the applicable provisions of War Department Readjustment Regulations 1-6, 16 February 1945, as amended.

b. All cash and proceeds from the sale of property upon the dissolution of officers' and noncommissioned officers' clubs, messes, and similar associations will be forwarded by check through command channels to the Custodian of Army Club and Mess Fund, War Department, the Pentagon, Washington, 25, D. C. Checks will be drawn to the order of Custodian, Army Club and Mess Fund, and will be accompanied by a certified copy of the terminal audit of the fund.

5. Unit records will be retired as provided in TM 12-259 Records Administration - Disposition of Records.

6. Unit Property Records will be disposed of in accordance with AR 35-6700, 19 September 1945.

7. Report by letter will be submitted to this headquarters when the actions directed in paragraph 4, 5, and 6 have been complied with.

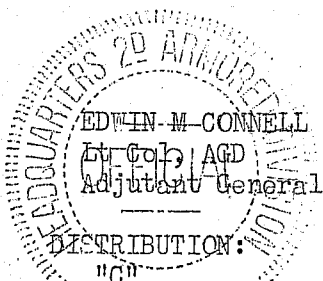
