5. OPERATIONS FOR PERIOD: (Brief summary including mention of excessive personnel losses which affect efficiency)

In morning hours all Unit Commanders and three Staff Officers made Reconnaissance of Positions to the Rear on the Intermediate MLR. At 1200 Hrs, Bn was alerted for a Night withdrawal to a New Line called the "Delaying Position". Co. "B" alerted to move under Bn control. Co. "C" 1st Plat. alerted to move a Section with the 274th Inf. Regt. and One Section with the 410th Inf. Regt. Co. "A" and Co. "C" (-) alerted to move with the 409th Inf. Regt. Bn. Hq., Hq. Co. and Co. "B" moved by infiltration starting at 1545 hrs and closing at 2300 hrs in the location shown above. Co. "A" and Co. "C" (-) were in route at close of period, Co. 1st Plat. remained in position. The 1st Rcn. Plat stood fast and continued on their Tank Warning Mission on Right Flank. The 2nd Rcn. Plat was relieved as of 1730 hrs and closed at Bn. CP at 2015 hrs.

5. OPERATIONS FOR PERIOD: (Brief summary including mention of excessive personnel losses which affect efficiency)

Bn. CP., Hq. Co. and Co. "B" remained the same. Company "A" and Co. "C" continued with their move. "C" company's last element closed at Zutzendorf at 1000 hrs after their last efforts to Salvage Equipment. Co. "C" lost two (2) 5" Guns, four (4) Halftracks and one (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Truck. Every effort was made to recover them but due to the Ice and Snow, lack of time and rough Terrain it was impossible to move them. Co. "A" lost one (1) 5" Gun, two (2) halftracks, two (2) $\frac{1}{2}$ Tons and one (1) $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Trailer. Elements of the Company came into Bueswiller all day. The Co. CO and 18 EM being the last in as a Bridge was blown behind them as they were trying to save 3" Gun, and had walked to new positions. Elements of all Companies put Guns in position as they came in and began digging them in. The end of the period found all Guns in and continuing to improve their positions. The 1st Ren. Plat. moved back to Pfaffenhoffen at 1600 hrs continuing on a Tank Warning Mission. The 2nd Ren. Plat. moved to Minbersheim at 1455 hrs with mission of keeping contact with the 813th T.D. Bn.
