AWARD OF DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS

1. By direction of the president and under the provisions of Sec I, Cir 32, Hq ETO US Army, 20 Mar 1944, as amended by Sec I, Cir 56, Hq ETO US Army, 27 Mar 1944, a Distinguished Service Cross is awarded posthumously to:

Lieutenant Colonel WILLIAM M. HERNANDEZ, 0191305, Field Artillery, United States Army, for extraordinary heroism in action on 20 August 1944 near ST VINCENT de BOIS, FRANCE. With utter disregard for his own safety Lieutenant Colonel HERNANDEZ personally directed the fire of one of his tank destroyers, silencing the enemy fires and enabling the forward movement of our troops to continue. His continuous presence with the forward elements combined with his exemplary judgment and leadership, maintained in the face of intense enemy fire, during which he was fatally wounded, set an inspiring example for his command, and are worthy of the best traditions of the service.

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

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6. AWARDS OF SILVER STAR MEDAL: Under the provisions of AR 600-45, a Silver Star Medal is awarded to the following named Officers and Enlisted Men;

ALLIE R. CLAYCOMB, 35250116, Technician Fourth Grade, United States Army for gallantry in action in Germany on 16 and 17 September 1944. When the unit with which Technician Fourth Grade Claycomb was serving as company aid man came under intense enemy artillery fire causing many casualties and forcing the unit to withdraw, Technician Fourth Grade Claycomb remained in the area under constant fire, treating the wounded and supervising their evacuation. On the following day when his unit again moved into the position and was exposed to intense enemy artillery, mortar and small arms fire, Technician Fourth Grade Claycomb, without regard for his personal safety, moved from wounded man to wounded man giving first aid and moving them to a safe position. The gallant conduct of Technician Fourth Grade Claycomb is worthy of the highest traditions of the military service.

7. AWARDS OF SILVER STAR MEDAL: Under the provisions of AR 600-45, a Silver Star Medal is awarded to the following Enlisted Men:

RUSSELL K. BURDEN, 35280117, Technician Fifth Grade, United States Army for gallantry in action in France on 20 August 1944. When a tank destroyer received a direct hit from enemy artillery seriously wounding three members of the crew, Technician Fifth Grade Burden and another enlisted man advanced under intense enemy machine gun and artillery fire and administered first aid to the wounded men and while attempting to load them on a one quarter ton ambulance a nearby artillery burst rendered Technician Fifth Grade Burden unconscious and wounded the other enlisted man who returned to the platoon command post for additional help. When Technician Fifth Grade Burden regained consciousness, he and a third enlisted man succeeded in evacuating the three wounded crew members to safety. The action of Technician Fifth Grade Burden is worthy of the highest traditions of the military service.

WARREN J. BEAM, 34386366, Private, United States Army for gallantry in action in France on 20 August 1944. When a tank destroyer received a direct hit from enemy artillery, seriously wounding three members of the crew, Private Beam and another enlisted man advanced under intense enemy machine gun and artillery fire and administered first aid to the wounded men and while attempting to load them on a one quarter ton ambulance a nearby artillery burst wounded Private Beam and rendered the other enlisted man unconscious. Private Beam, unable to be of any further assistance, worked his way back on foot to the platoon command post where he secured additional help and the three wounded men were evacuated to safety. The action of Private Beam is worthy of the highest traditions of the military service.

ALFRED B. AMES, 36400216, Private First Class, United States Army for gallantry in action in Germany on 17 September 1944. Although wounded on the previous night, Private First Class Ames had refused medical evacuation and continued on duty. The tank destroyer platoon leader was forced to leave his vehicle below the crest of a hill to avoid direct enemy observation and proceeded forward on foot to direct fire against the enemy. Private First Class Ames acted as his messenger and, without regard for his own safety, continuously negotiated the distance between the platoon leader and the guns of the platoon and thus enabled the gun crews to lay accurate fire on the enemy positions. During this action Private First Class Ames was again wounded and had to be evacuated. His actions are worthy of the highest traditions of the military service.

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8. AWARD OF SILVER STAR MEDAL: Under the provisions of AR 600-45, a Silver Star Medal is posthumously awarded to JOHN KALIS, 36015718, Sergeant, United States Army for gallantry in action in Germany on 17 September 1944. When his unit was attacked by enemy artillery, mortar and small arms fire, Sergeant Kalis advanced on foot, without regard for his own safety, for the purpose of directing fire on the enemy positions. Later on that same day he left the turret of the tank destroyer which he commanded to fire a machine gun against advancing enemy foot troops. When the machine gun jammed, Sergeant Kalis remained exposed to enemy fire until he had cleared the stoppage and then resumed fire until the attack was repulsed. Subsequently his tank destroyer was hit by enemy mortar fire and Sergeant Kalis was fatally wounded. His gallantry and aggressive leadership reflects the highest traditions of the United States Army.



SUBJECT: Battle Participation Credits.

1. Information is requested as to the exact battles and campaigns for which this Battalion is entitled to receive Battle Participation Credit, the number of Streamers and Silver Bands authorized, and the number of bronze Service Stars which members of this Battalion are entitled to wear on their European Theater Service Ribbons.

2. On the basis of what information this Headquarters has received on this subject to date, it is believed this Battalion is entitled to credit for three awards as follows:

a. Air Battle of England - as Battalion was operating a Marshalling Camp (D Area), in England from 11 April 1944 to 4 July 1944, and had secondary role of furnishing anti-paratroop security from 1 June 1944 to 15 June 1944.

b. Battle of France - as Battalion entered combat in France 2 August 1944 and participated in drive to Le Mans, the Falaise-Argentan Gap, Evreux-Seine River action, march to Valenciennes and drive through to Luxembourg arriving at that point 9 September 1944.

c. Battle of Germany - as Battalion was active in the Wallendorf to Stockem, Germany penetration 13 September 1944 to 23 September 1944, and the Hurtgen Forest operation in December, 1944.

3. Reason for request for this information at this time is due to numerous and repeated inquiries concerning this matter by the enlisted and commissioned personnel of this organization, and it is felt that an official statement concerning these awards would be a beneficial morale factor.

I--AWARD OF DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS-- Under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, and pursuant to authority contained in paragraph 3c, Section I, Circular 32, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, United States Army, 20 March 1944, as amended, the Distinguished Service Cross is awarded to the following officer:

First Lieutenant Leon A. Rennebaum, 01822055, 628th Tank Destroyer Battalion, United States Army, for extraordinary heroism in action against the enemy on 16 and 17 September 1944, in Germany. In a stubborn engagement with superior enemy forces attempting to encircle a hill held by our troops, First Lieutenant Rennebaum risked his life on innumerable occasions to bring effective fire from his tank destroyers in support of the infantry. Time and time again, he braved devastating enemy artillery and machine gun fire, moving on foot to forward elements of the infantry and to his tank destroyer units to direct their fire upon the enemy. When three of his destroyers were disabled, First Lieutenant Rennebaum coolly and calmly supervised their evacuation under fire and personally returned to the scene of action to recover a remaining vehicle. On another occasion, he courageously drove to the crest of a hill subjected to heavy artillery and mortar fire and, from his exposed position, singlehandedly poured a hail of machine gun fire into attacking hostile troops, forcing them to retreat. Entered military service from New Jersey.
