I - AWARDS OF SILVER STAR MEDALS: Under the provisions of AR 600-45, as amended, and Memorandum 34, Headquarters, Ninth United States Army, 8 September 1944, as amended, the Silver Star Medal is awarded to:

First Lieutenant MONROE S HALL 01165700 Tank Destroyer, 638th Tank Destroyer Battalion (Attached 84th Infantry Division), United States Army. For gallantry in action against the enemy in Germany, 26 November 1944. While leading a platoon of tank destroyers whose mission was the destruction of enemy pillboxes which were holding up an infantry advance, First Lieutenant Hall, exposing himself to continuous enemy small arms and automatic fire, without regard for his own safety personally directed his guns to firing positions, from which an enemy pillbox was put out of action. The individual bravery under fire, commendable leadership and devotion to duty displayed by this officer reflect high credit upon himself and the military service. Entered military service from Florida.
