#### 9 Jaz. 45.

Disembarked from USS LET 246 at LINGAIN, LUZON, P.I., at 1600. Joined Rom. Plateen for night bivenes at LINGAIN, LUZON, P.I., at 1630. Lt. Skye (1st Plateen) reported 2 ensualties, Sgt. George Schaedler, shrappel wounds about the legs sustained during an air attack over LINGAINN GULF. PTC Elno A. Careseni, flesh wounds in the mesk. Same circumstances as in the case of Sgt. Schaedler. Both casualties coourred aboard USS LET 272.

# 20 202. 45.

ist Ron. Platoon laft on ressonaissance Binale areat at 1930. At 1330 Platoon returned to area. He encounter with the encourt

## 11 Jan. 45.

Company loss 1st Rom. Plateon supply and maintenance cohelon left on recommissance of AGUILAR AREA at 0745. Recommissions party reached AGUILAR (9 miles) 1200. Continued recommissionse temari MANGATAREN. At 1800 Recommissionse party returned to AGUILAR for bivene. No contest with enemy.

# 12 Jan. 45.

Supplies and maintenance eres went to AUMIAR to resupply Recommissance party.

## 13 Jan. 45.

Rear schelon left LINGAYIN for AGUILAR at 1300. Behelon reached AGUILAR and prepared to bivouse at 2700. At 1800 Recommissance party returned to AGUILAR bivouse from recommissance as far south as MANGATAREM. We contact with enemy. It. Hermandes of the Philippine Scouts joined Company at MANGATAREM. Recommended by Captain Bolo of the P.I. Querillas.

## 14 Jan. 45.

Received orders from Battalion CO at OS65 not to make recommissance any farther south than MANGATAREM. Egt. Asmold and Pvt. Ashlock made foot recommissance east of MANGATAREM across the AGEO RIVER as far as URBOSTIOF and made contact with the 37th Division (148th Infantry Regiment) at that point. These two men passed through Jap hald territory and civilians told them that at times they were within only a few yards of Japs. However, the two men returned to the Company area without insident.

15-16-17 Jan. 45. Company remained at AGUILAR for maintenance. He risconnaissance made.

# 18 Jan. 45.

Reconnaissance Platoons and Pionser Platoon laft AGUIIAR at 0800 to reconnoiter an overland route between AGUIIAR AND CANILING. All platoons returned at about 1700 and reported that cross-country route is not practical, that the highway was best route even though all bridges would have to be by-passed. 2nd Platoon which reconnoitered in the foothills northwest of MAGATAREM encountered several Jap foot troops. The Japs were fired on and one wounded. This Jap was taken by 5 Sgt. Garling, Cpl Baseconcillic. Another Jap was taken prisoner by T/5 Sommers and Sgt. Asmold. Both prisoners were turned over to S-R, 160th Infantry Begiment at MANGATAREM.

# 19 Jan. 45. Entire Company noved from AGUILAR to CAMILING (20 miles).

## 20 22. 45.

Entire Company left GANILING for MANBURAN at OSCO where supply and maintenance remained and Recommaissance and Pioneer Platoons continued on recommaissance with TARIAG as their objective. At 1730 supply and maintenance joined rest of Company at SAN JUAN DE MATA. Recommaissance Report for the day — Our Recommaissance elements reached TARIAG just in time to see in the distance the last Jap truck evacuating TARIAG to the south. No engagements were made. TARIAC was laft in complete ruim by the Japs.

#### 21 22. 45.

At 1030 Company Left SAN JUAN DE MATA for nove to TARIAC. At 1830 last elemente arrived at TARIAC for night bivecas.

# 22 Jan. 45.

At 0700 3 Reconnaissance Platoons and Piencer Platoon left TARIAC on mission of reconnaissance south. Reconnaissance elements reached GAPAS at 1100. Engaged enery in fire fight on southern outskirts of the town. It. Corder and Sgt. Ellison killed one Jap. The Jap infected area was sprayed prefusely with mechine gun and rifle and J700 Cannister. While most of the Japa fled others are believed to have been killed or wounded, but not accounted for. Continued reconnaissance east to CONCEPCION and contacted the 37th Div. Ron. Elements there, and returned south to SAE KIQUEL at 2030 the river was crossed with much difficulty. At times that day the entire reconnaissance group crossing would have been impossible had it not had a helf-track and minch with the Bioneer Flatoon. At 1430 supply and maintenance left TARIAC for nove to SAE WIGHEL and arrived at SAE MIGUEL at 1530. Five miles.

## 23 Jan. 45.

Entire Company left SAE MIQUEL for CONCEPCION. Arrived at CONCEPCION at 0900 without incident. This Company establishes first OF in CONCEPCION. At 0900 Reconnaissance Plateous less 1 section of the 2nd Plateou and Pioneer Plateou left CONCEPCION on route recommaissance south toward MiGAIANG area. Recommaissance remebed read junction just morth of MiGAIANG at 1700. MAGAIANG was known at this time to be hold by 200 Japs, with seven light tanks. Artillary was requested but was out of range. Recommaissance group advanced on town from North, East and Nest and emgaged energy in a fire fight morth of tewn, destroying two trucks and killing 1 Jap Officer and about 25 ME. Pvt. John Wilson was seen to now three Jape down with his .30 Cal. Mechine gun. The Company received rifle, mechine gun, 37MM and morter fire. After a twenty minute fight without casualties reorganized at SAN ROOMS 3 miles north of MiGAIANG. Proceeded to our OF at CONCEPCION and arrived there at 1900.

# 24 Jan. 45.

Company received mission of determining energy still in MAGAIANG and to continue if possible, south to MENICO. At 0930 3 Reconnaisennes Platoons and Pioneer Platoon left CONCEPCION on above mission. Encountered and engaged in fire fight with small Jap force estimated at 30 men and one light tank at SAN ROOM. Company withdrew morth to MARAH RIVER and established defensive positions along north bank to demy crossings to small energy amered unit reported to be in the area. In the above engagement one energy michine gas nests was destroyed at SAN ROOME. Sgt. Carling did the beners there. An undetermined number of Japs were killed. The Company was relieved of our defensive positions at about 1500 by the 145th Infantry Regiment. Networed to Gempany area. No essenties. At 1630 entire Company moved to Battalion GP area. Barrio of BOHOMES just morth of GAPAS.

# 35 Jan. 45. Company remained in area for maintenance of equipment and rest.

## 26 Jan. 45.

Mission: Recommissione Company in force to CAMP STOTSENBURG and CLARK FIELD AREA. Recommaissance Platcons and Pioneer Platcon and one Platcon of medium tanks attached (742nd Tank Battalion) and one Platoon of M-10 TD's ("H" Company, 640th TD Bn.) at OSOO laft Company area on above mission. Observed many Jap foot troops and artillery and machine gum installation on hill morth of DOLORRS, in CLARK FIELD AREA. Received Jap artillery fire and moved back under cover in line along MANILA RAILROAD. Called on artillery fire on area and air strike. It. Corder directed artillery fire from a Gub observation plane. Resumed mission and received heavy artillary fire from DEFERES in STOTSENBURG AREA. We withdrew to the vicinity of the MANITA RAILROAD, this was about 1600. Jap rifle and machine gum fire was encountered throughout the day. Tec 5 Sommers with his 37114 destroyed an enery OF. Pioneer Platcon removed two improvised mines near RUEMAY NO. 1. NORTH CLARK FIRID. Returned to bivouse area at DOLORES. He casualties. Several supply dusps were castured and turned over to Air Gorss Intelligence. Castured Jap documents state that there is a small mechanized force operates well in advance of the U.S. Infantry. Insaged them in several fire fights.

27-28 Jan. 45. Mintenance and rest in Company area at DOLORES.

29 Jan. 45.

Company moved from DOLCRES to CAPAS. This was an administrative move and mothing of incident happened.

30 Jan. 45. No events.

31 Jan. 45. One section of 1st Recommissance Platoon and Pioneer Platoon left on a mission to help remove wrecked M-10 from hills west of MANBAN.

1 700. 45.

At 0530 arrived GUINEA. Stopped for refueling and to est and them moved south to MAIAPIAP, where the entire Company received a small amount of sniper fire. Three Recommaissance Plateen and Piencer section remained at MAYAPYAP in observation and support of Infantry. Remainder of Company returned two miles morth to CALIBAMBANGAN and prepared night bivounc. All plateens returned to bivounc area at 1330.

2 Feb. 45.

Attached to 12th Gavalry Regiment at MAXAPTAP. 2nd Plateon attached to "A" Gompany with mission of reconnoitering area morth and east of PAMPANGA RIVER. Company less 2nd Plateon assigned mission of reconnoitering area east of CABANATUAN. Left area 0730 and engaged unuary in visinity of PANCAD. Captured one prisener and killed four Japs. 3rd Plateon engaged approximately 200 Japs cast of MANCAD. Killed undetermined number, reported by civilians to be 25. Reconnoitered MALIPID LANDING FIKLD. Disengaged energy 1830. Returned to bivouse area at MAXAPTAP. Lt. Corder injured hand and arm during fire fight.

3 Feb. 45.

Mission same as 2 Feb. Attached to Company one Platoon of 21 men from 12th Cavabry Regiment. Sgt. Morrison in charge. 1st Platoon engaged enemy at BANGAD. Killed two Japs. Captured CAMANATUAN PRISON CAMP No. 1 at PANGADIAN 1200. Sedured documents, etc. Platoon from 12th Gavalry Regiment proceeded on foot to MCATRANG. Genpany reached GABU at 1600. 3rd Platoon patrelled to MCATBANG, brought out one British see captain who had hidden there from Prison Camp No. 1. 1st Platoon moved across GABU GREEK engaged three hundred energy in bivouse area. Killed three during afternoon, undetermined number wounded. Piencer Platoon placed mortar fire on Jap positions killing two, undetermined number wounded. Company disengaged and returned to area at 1900. 2nd Platoon attached to "A" Company had no contact with energy. No casualties.

#### 4 Feb. 45.

Lt. Corder evacuated. 1st Sgt. Enight replaced him as Platoon Leader of 3rd Platoon. S Sgt Mecham became asting 1st Sgt. Entire Company had same mission as previous day. No direct contact with enemy. No casualties. Returned to bivouse area &t 1700.

#### 5 Feb. 45.

2nd Reconnaissance Plateon petrolled to CABU CREEK. No contact with the energy. 3rd Plateon patrolled to RIZAL and contacted 6th Division. No energy contact. Remainder of Company remained in bivouse area at MAXAPXAP. Units returned to area at 1300. No ensublines.

## 6 Feb. 45.

lst Reconnaissance Platoon left on reconnaissance at 0800. Returned to hivouae area near MATAPLAP at 1730. He casualties.

#### 7 Feb. 45.

3rd Recommaissance Platoon left on recommaissance mission at 0800. Contacted gaserills forces whe reported small group of lightly armed Japs cross river from CABU. Captured one prisoner of 103rd Division. Returned to area at 1630. No casualties.

#### 8 Peb. 45.

3rd Reconnaissance Plateon left on reconnaissance 1200. Contacted elements of 6th Division. Reported in at 1500. Maintained read block at CASIL during night. Pioneer Plateon made reconnaissance forward as far as CABU and CABU RIVER. No contact with energy. Civilians reported Japs had moved out a few days age. Returned to area at 1730. No casualties.

#### 9 Feb. 45.

Rear echelon contacted 2nd and 3rd Plateons by redio at 0900. Platcons on recomnaiseance and establishing read blocks in visinity of MAYAFYAF. Returned to bivouse area at 1700. No contact with energy. No casualties.

# 10 Feb. 45.

Lt. Partirdge with advanced echalem left bivound area at MAXAPTAP at GBOD enrouse to ROSARIO HEIGHTS ENTENSION, MANILA. Han into enemy mortar and rifle fire at WOVALICHES. Arrived at ROSARIO NEIGHTS, MANILA at 1930 with no casualties. Established contast with 12th Regimental Headquarters. Remainder of Gempany left MAXAFTAP at 1120 for ROSARIO HEIGHTS, MANILA traveling with Battalion convoy. Leeding vehicles in that convoy were fired upon by enemy mortars near NOVALICHES. Battalion drew back and established biveums area for night near BUSTOS. Distance traveled 56 miles. 2nd and 3rd Recommaissance Platoons and Pioneer Flatoons were sent forward on recemplication east as far as NOVALICHES to determine strength of enemy in that section. Encountered enemy mortar fire. Fired on enemy positions with 37MM. Obtained direct hits. Enemy casualties unknown. Returned to bivouse area 1900. Ho casualties.

## 11 Pob. 45.

Entire Battalion convoy turned back approximately five miles to by-pass enemy strong point. Took National Highway to ROSARIO HEIGHTS EXTENSION. Convoy left 0800 and arrived at new bivounc area, ROSARIO HEIGHTS at 1200. One Jap sniper was killed by Sgt. Ellison at 1600 near bivouse area.

## 12 Feb. 45.

3rd Reconnaissance Platoon left on reconnaissance at 1200 south and east approximately 10 miles. Returned to area 1500. No contact with ensuy. No casualties. Remainder of Company remained in bivouac area for maintenance of equipment. Company received sniper and 2. cal. machine gun fire early in evaning. Returned fire. No casualties. Ferro, Nicholas was injured by booky trap at OSOO. Hospitalization not required.

## 13 Feb. 45.

First Reconnections Platoon left at 1500 on reconnectionance mission south and east as far as MANDALETONG AIRFIELD. Approximate distance of 4 miles. Ran into energy machine gun and emiper fire. Returned fire. Undetermined number of Japs killed and wounded. Noved one half mile farther on and encountered more energy machine gun fire. One energy killed by PFC Garesoni. Others wounded and killed. Number undetermined. Lt. Noren of Company "A", accompanied first platoon on mission. 3rd Platoon left at 0930 on routine patrol and reconnected mission. Returned to area at 1400. No centert with the energy and no casualties.

## 24 Feb. 45.

Ist Platoon had same mission as 13 Feb. No contact with energy. Also reconnoitered as far as river east of GAMP MURPHY. Heturned to bivewas area at 1200. He casualties. 2nd Reconnaissance Platoon left on mission to secure north bank of PASIG RIVER. South and west of MANERIANYONG AINFIELD, accompanied by one Platoon of "A" Company and one troop of 7th Cavalry Regiment. Supported by artillery 2nd Platoon asting as spearhead for force sited Japs morth of FT. MONIMIEY, MANIA, received amiper fire, located numerous pill boxes and energy dug outs. FFC Wrights and Tec 5 Sommers destroyed one energy machine gum, one gas truck and one ammunition truck with 37MK fire. FFC Denmis and PFG Wrights were credited with one energy sample. Ondetermined number killed and wounded. Heturned to bivewas area 1600. No easualties.

#### 15 Feb. 45.

3rd Reconnaissance Plateon left on reconnaissance mission at 0730, working with "A" Company. Engaged energy morth of PASIC RIVIE opposite FORT MOMINLEY. Milled two energy. Returned to area 1535. No casualties. Sgt. Ellison returned from mission completed from DINALUPIHAN. While there supped one mine field. Lt. Remington with one Pionser section left on recommunissance mission to GALIPAN. Meturned at 1530 and brought back four wounded guerrillas for medical treatment.

## 16 Feb. 45.

1st Section of 1st Recommaissance Platoon left on recommaissance at 0800 to DARANNA. Thile leading convoy of engineers they drew energy fire. Returned fire. Killed one Japand pushed on two miles. Engaged energy in battle one hundred yards from BARANNA CEMETERY. Killed five energy and undetermined number wounded. Relieved at 1130 by 1st Section, 3rd Platoon. Returned to the area with no casualties. 1st Section, 3rd Platoon drew energy fire at cross-road near BARANNA, returned fire. Undetermined number energy killed and wounded. Returned to area 1600. No casualties.

#### 17 Teb. 45.

Company loss 3rd Plateon, second section of Pionser Plateon and Hqs. Section left biveuxe area at ROSARIO HEIGHTS at 1200 with Division mission or recommoitaring area west of NOVALICHES to MANILA - DAGUPAN RAILROAD south of SAPANGULAT RIVER and to destroy any enemy found. Bivousced at POLO STATION near MALANDAY. No contact with enemy and no ossualties.

# 18 Feb. 45.

Same mission as Feb. 17th. Completed at 1200. No contact with enemy. Attached to 1st Squadron, 112th Cavalry, SANTA MARIA. Reported to Colonel Grant at 1400. 1st Recommaissance Flatoon made reconnaissance from SANTA MARIA to SAN VINCENTE and HOT COENCE. Received artillery fire from the enemy. Remainder of elements were on mission to contact and destroy energy reported in viginity of PRENSA. Established contast at PREMEA at 1700. Rescued 46 enlisted men and one officer of Company "B", 1279th Aviation Engineer Battalion that had been out off by enemy. Engaged enemy in heavy battle at this point. It. R.K. Allsup, 2nd Platoon leader received wound in back of neck from sniper fire. Sgt. Stanley Asmold was wounded in chest by energy machine gun fire. Lost one 1 ton with radio. .30 caliber machine gun, rocket Launcher, one M-1 Rifle, two carbines, one pistol, one pair binoculars and Battalion SOI. Vehicle was later destroyed by 37MM gun at 1920. 14 Japs were killed and an undetermined number killed and wounded. Jap force estimated at 150. Disengaged at 1930. Returned to SANTA MARIA. It. Allsup and Sgt. Asmold taken to 23rd Field Hospital. Rear echelon at ROSARIO HEIGHTS, MANILA, was fired upon from 1800 to 0600 by energy artillery. John. F. Grant received wound in right thigh from shrapnel. He other casualties.

# 19 200. 45.

Sgt. Stanley C. Asmold died at 0200 after operation. Element returned to PRENSA supported by one tank platoon and "O" Troop, Sth Cavalry Regiment. No contact with the enemy. Evacuated one engineer and one MP killed in that vicinity previous day. Found 1 ton truck which was lost previous day. 30 saliber machine gun, rocket launcher, small arms, radio transmitter and receiver had been taken. Returned to SANTA MARIA 1600. Second section Planeer Platoon returned from EATAAN, joined unit at NARICO RIVER at 1200. Relieved of attachment with 112th Cavalry. Returned to Company CP which had been moved from ROSARIO HEIGHTS, MANIA to ESPANA EXTENSION, ESPANA BOULEVARD, MANILA. Lt. Allsup's condition very bod. Evacuated to 21st Field Hospital awaiting evacuation to States.

#### 20 Feb. 45.

It. R.K. Allsup died. Company remained in bivousc area at ESPANA EXTENSION, MANILA for maintenance of equipment.

21 Feb. 45. Company remained in bivouss area for maintenance of vehicles and equipment.

22 Feb. 45.

Company less Headquarter Section left at 1112 for F(RT MERINIEY, MANILA with mission of reconnoitering trails and routes eastward to the TATTAY - ANGONO RCAD. Attached to 302nd Reconnaissance Troops. Rear echsion at ESPANA EXTENSION, MANILA.

#### 23 Feb. 45.

lst and 2nd Reconnaissance Platoons patrolled from FORT MEKINLEY to SAMTA ANA and south east to PASIG RIVER HRIDGE. Returned to area at 1300. No contact with enemy and me oasualties. Pioneer Platoon and 3rd Reconnaissance Platoon left for ANGONO at 0900. Here attached to 302nd Reconnaissance Troops, for reconnaissance patrols in area TATTAY - GARDONA. 1st and 2nd Reconnaissance Platoons remained at FORT MCKINLEY with responsibility of securing Fort and Division zone scuth of PASIG RIVER. Attached to Company at FORT MCKINLEY for support in securing Fort, 97 (Hunter's Cuerrillas), ROTC Major Dodo DeMontes in charge. 24 Feb. 45. Rear echelon left ESPANA EXTENSION, MANILA, at 1200 enroute to FORT MCKINLEY. Arrived at Fort at 1400. 1st and 2nd Reconnaissance Platoons there. During the night of the 24th Feb. Pioneer Platoon and 3rd Reconnaissance Platoon were attack by approximately 50 Japs. The Japs attempted a Banzai attack, the first Japs were sighted by Pionser Platoan about 60 feet from the perimeter. They fired on the energy with .50 caliber machine guns and small arms. The fight lasted 30 minutes, during which time the enemy three enemy hand grenades and knee mortars inside the perimeter. Pioneer and 3rd Platoon returned fire with 3744 Cannister and 81m mortars. 26 energy killed, remaining number withdrew to hills. Lt. Remington and PFC williams slightly wounded by shrapnel from energy fire. 25 Feb. 45. Platoons remained in area for maintenance of equipment and rest. 26 Feb. 45. Lt. Remington and PFC Williams were sent to hospital for treatment of wounds. Attached guarrillas guarding north gate of FOET MCKINLEY killey one Jap. No casualtica One encay killed in bivouse area at Fort as he was attempting to sneak through at 2200. 27 F . 45. Reconnaissance men and guerrillas killed 16 energy in vicinity of 10RT MENTILLY. One guerrills slightly wounded. 28 Feb. 45. Reconneissance men from 1st and 2nd Reconnaissance Platoon and guerrillas killed 4 Japs at PASIG RIVER MIDOE and killed one Jap at North gate of Fort. One guerrille killed by energy hand grenade. PFC Miller and PFC Caresoni killed two Japs in terms of SANTA ANA. PFC Ashlock and guerrillas killed two energy on road between FCRT NOKINLEY and SANTA ANA. 1 Mar. 45. 2nd Recommaissance Platoon left on patrol 0930 returned 1200. No contact. No casualties. 2nd Plateen left 1300 on recommaissance in vicinity of SANTA ANA. Castured one Mahapili, and turned him over to C.I.C. for investigation. 2 har. 45. Noutine patrels sent out. Six Jap snipers killed by Reconnaissance men and guerrillas near FORT MolINIET at 1130. One more killed at 1900 by South Cate. 3 mr. 45. Hendquarter Section, 1st and 2nd Recommaissance Platoons left FCMT MCKINLKY 1330 joined Pioneer and 3rd Platoons at ANGONO at 1600. Distance traveled 20 miles. Company relieved from responsibility for security of FORT MONINERY AREA and Division Zone south of PASIG RIVER, effective 031400. Company reverts to Battalion control. Pioneer and 3rd Platoons relieved from attachment to 302nd Reconnaissance Troops. Company mission to protect Division Right (South) flank, of patrolling and securing area TAYTAY to CARDONA on Highway 21 and areas adjacent to a depth of 2000 yards and relieve 2nd Cavalry Brigade road block (ANOCNO) at 031200. 4 Mar. 45. Regular patrol's last this morning at 0930 returned to bivouse area 1400. No contact with energy. No casualties.

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5 Mar. 45. Same as previous day.

6 Mar. 45.

Pioneer Demolition Crew, Lt. Remington in charge, 4 men from 3rd Platoon and Lie Knight left on mission for MORONG 0930. MORONG RIVER bridge was blown out making it impossible for vehicles to cross. Pioneer Demolition Crew consisting of five men accompanied by 10 guerrillas went forward on fost patrol mission of mining road near MAYBANGAL ROAD JUNCTION. Party was attacked on northern outskirts of MORONG by about 15 Japs armed with .25 caliber rifles and machine guns. Exact number of weapons unknown. Lt. Remington's men, Gregorie F. Pura, Cpl., who was a member of Philippine Scouts before fall of Luson was wounded in left hand by energy rifle fire. Patrol returned to area 1500. 2nd Reconnaissance Platoon maintaining road block at ANGONO. Relieved by let Reconnaissance Platoon at 1530.

7 Mar. 45. lat Reconnaissance Platoon maintaining road block at HOSARIC, 3rd Platoon maintaining road block at ANGONO.

8 Mar. 45. 1st Reconnaissance Platoon maintaining road block at ROSARIO, 3rd Reconnaissance Platoon and attached guerrillas maintaining road block at ANGONO, 2nd Reconnaissance Platoon and Headquarter Section remained in bivousc area at ANGONO. Attached guerrillas maintaining outpost south and east of ANGONO.

9 Mar. 45. 3rd Reconnaissance Platoon m

3rd Reconnaissance Platoon maintaining road block at ANGONO. 1st and 2nd Reconnaissance Platoons and Pioneer Platoon remained in bivousc area. Received energy artillery fire 2200. He casualties. Pioneer Platoon fired on energy positions in foot hills near bivouse area with SiMM mortar at 1100. Results unknown.

10 Mar. 45. 2nd Heconneissance Platoon relieved 3rd Reconneissance Platoon on Road Junction block at ANUMNO at 0930. Pioneer Platoon made reconneissance south and east to MORGNG. No contact with enemy. Returned to area 1600.

11 Mar. 45. 1st Reconnaissance Plateon left 0930 for reconnaissance patrol to MCRONG. Returned t

to area at 1230. No contact with energy. 2nd Reconstiggance Platoon maintaining road block at ANGCNO.
