

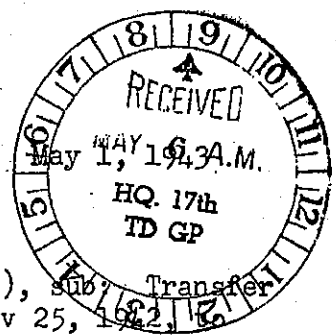

ACTIVATION DAY

I. Two years ago today this organization was activated as a self-propelled battalion at Camp Bowie, Texas. At a formation of the enlisted cadre of seventy-six (76) and the original officers, the activation orders, General Orders 1 and Special Orders Number 1 were read. The Commanding Officer, MAJOR B.R. FARR, spoke briefly. With this simple ceremony, the Battalion was born.

II. One year ago today this organization had just returned from four weeks of maneuvers in the Tennessee Maneuver Area. Three days before the General Orders reorganizing as a towed battalion had been issued. That night a beer party was had in the Headquarters building. We had a year of hard work behind us. We were off to a new start.

III. Today this organization has completed its' first two weeks at the front. We are preparing to reorganize as a self-propelled Battalion. The Battalion and its' organic units are being commended for performance of combat duties. We are moving into Hitler's Reich. The hopes of the original Activation Day and of its first anniversary are being realized.

IV. I desire to express my appreciation to each of you for the highly commendable manner in which you have performed your duties in combat. You have demonstrated the highest qualities of courage, leadership and devotion to duty. Your performance in your first weeks of combat is worthy of the highest praise.

V. Each of us is proud of the past two years. Each of us will be proud of the future.

(2) These instructions prohibit the operation of captured vehicles which do not bear U. S. or Allied authorized registration numbers and cover all classes of vehicles including motorcycles and bicycles.

(3) All captured vehicles in use must have, in addition to a standard trip ticket, a true copy of the authority to retain vehicle, certified by the unit commander.

(4) Vehicles operated by civilians under supervision of Military Government will bear identification issued by the Military Government.

(5) All unregistered vehicles in the hands of troops will be turned into the nearest Ordnance Collecting Point.





During this critical period of rapid advance and extended supply lines it is important that every means possible be employed to keep all containers in circulation including captured equipment.

f. Vehicle Markings. Unit commanders will take necessary action to insure that vehicles are properly marked in accordance with AR 850-5, and changes thereto, as soon as practicable. Bumpers will be kept clean and obliterated or partially obliterated markings will be repainted.

g. Supply & Maintenance Discipline. The critical food and transportation situation combine to make paramount the emphasis on conservation of supplies and maintenance of equipment. Commanders of all Echelons will continuously give supply and maintenance discipline their personal attention.

h. Conservation of Gasoline.

- (1) Long supply lines and limited transportation make it imperative that commanders of all Echelons take immediate and forceful action to conserve gasoline.
- (2) Discontinuance of the following is directed.
 - (a) Use of motor transportation except for essential military requirements.

 - (c) Idling of motors.
 - (d) Use of gasoline for open fires.
 - (e) Unnecessary use of gasoline consuming generators, etc.
 - (f) Hoarding gasoline.

- (3) Resupply of gasoline is further aggravated by failure of units to return cans to supply points. Remedial action will be taken.

i. Captured Enemy Vehicles.

- (1) Reference is made to Par. 9 a (4), Section V (Ordnance Instrs), Adm Instrs No 3, Third U. S. Army.
- (2) These instructions prohibit the operation of captured vehicles which do not bear U. S. or Allied authorized registration numbers and cover all classes of vehicles including motorcycles and bicycles.
- (3) All captured vehicles in use must have, in addition to a standard trip ticket, a true copy of the authority to retain vehicle, certified by the unit commander.
- (4) Vehicles operated by civilians under supervision of Military Government will bear identification issued by the Military Government.
- (5) All unregistered vehicles in the hands of troops will be turned in to the nearest Ordnance collecting point.

- (1) It is imperative that units submit required reports. Information necessary to comply with Third Army and III Corps directives was distributed with Adm O No 13, Hq III Corps, subject: "Supply Reports."





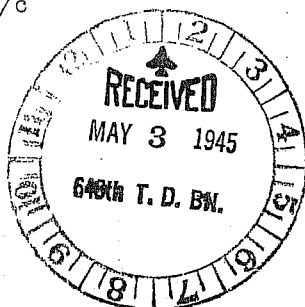

It is important that every means possible be employed to keep all containers in circulation including captured equipment, that care be taken not to lose or damage cans, and that all cans be recovered.
- (6) Gasoline supply is critical. Issues of gasoline to units is increasing and indicate that a critical shortage, which will result in strict rationing of gas, will develop unless commanders of all echelons rigidly limit operation of vehicles under their control to essential driving only.
- (7) It has been directed that, because of the critical supply of rations, especially C and K, Allied PWs, Enemy PWs and Displaced persons will be subsisted on captured enemy supplies. All Commanders will upon capture, inventory, assemble, and guard until relieved all captured food supplies. It is the responsibility of all commanders that no captured military or civilian German subsistence is consumed by U. S. personnel.

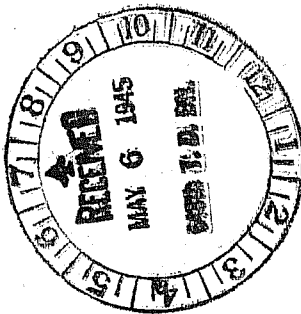
