Citations: (Cont'd) James R. Bush. 30002980, awarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action in France on 2 August 1944. When the tank destroyer, on which Opl Bush was a gumer, was heavily engaged by enemy tanks and infantry, he immediately opened fire. Although his vehicle was hit three times by direct fire and part of the crew wounded, Col Bush succeeded in destreying three enemy tanks. His personal bravery, loyalty, and determination reflects great credit upon himself and is in keeping with the highest traditions of the Armed Forces. Technician Fifth Grade Francisco C. Davalos, 18068414, awarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action in France on 2 August 1944. 1/5 Davales, unable to proceed forward with his tank destroyer when his Combat Team came under direct fire of several German tanks, dismounted and under heavy machine gun and rifle fire went forward on foot and made an estimate of the situation. He then returned and brought forward his tank destroyer and placed it in the position he had chosen, informing the car commander of the situation, and pointing out the enemy tanks. His personal bravery and utter disregard for his own personal safety enabled the tank destroyers to knock out four enemy tanks. His action reflects great credit upon himself and is in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service. Sgt Frank L. Miller, 32213659, awarded the Bronze Star for hereic achievement in action against the enemy in France on 2 August 1944. Col Melvin H. Stoddard, 31064308, awarded the Bronze Star for heroic achievement in action against the enemy in France on 28 July 1944. Pvt Lloyd M. Pepper, 55799306, awarded the Bronse Star for heroic achievement in action against the enemy in France on 11 August 1944. 2nd Lt Marion L.
