19 - February.

Bivouac at Orleansville, North Africa. Left bivouac 23 miles east of Oran 9:20 A.M. arrived at Orleansville 5:10 P.M. Distance by motor convoy 117 miles.

20 - February.

L'Arba, North Africa. Left Orleansville at 7:00 A.M. arrived at L'Arba, 4:00 P.M. Distance 133 miles.

21 - February.

Bivouac area. Left L'Arba 9:20 A.M. arrived bivouac 6:00 P.M. Distance 104 miles.

22 - February.

Bivouac 20 miles west of Constantine. Left bivouac area at 6:00 A.M. Arrived at bivouac at 6:00 P. M. Distance 164 miles.

- 23 - February.
Bivouac area 20 miles west of Constantine, Usual guard and camp duties.
- 24 - February.
Bivouac area 8 miles east of LeKef. Left bivouac near Constantine 7:30 A.M. arrived new bivouac 8:00 P.M. Distance 195 miles by motor convoy.
- 25 - February.
Bivouac area 1 mile east of Rohia. Left bivouac near LeKef 1:30 P.M. arrived Rohia 6:30 P.M. Occupied positions 1 1/2 miles east of Rohia. Distance 63 miles.
- 26 - February.
Sbiba. Advanced 10 miles and occupied positions near Sbiba.
- 27 - 28 February.
Sbiba. Occupied alternate positions.

M A R C H - 1 9 4 3

- 1 - 4 March.
Sbiba, North Africa. Occupied gun positions.
- 5 - 6 March.
Advanced 20 miles and withdrew to Sbiba, arriving at 10:00 A.M.
- 7 - 12 March.
Sbiba, North Africa bivouac area. Engaged in patrol activities. Contact was made with enemy. 29 rounds of 75mm were fired.

Sbiba, North Africa bivouac area. Performing security guard and usual camp duties.

20 - March.

Sbiba, North Africa bivouac area. Performing guard and usual camp duties. 2nd Heavy Destroyer Platoon engaged enemy near Hadjeb and advanced on enemy under fire. Sergeant E. L. Smith's destroyer section destroyed one enemy heavy armored car. Distance traveled 51 miles.

21 - March.

Sbiba, North Africa bivouac area performing security guard and usual duties. 2nd Heavy Destroyer Platoon made contact with enemy at 3:30 P.M. near Hadjeb Sergeant Cherry's destroyer section exchanged fire with enemy.

22 - March.

Sbiba, North Africa bivouac area performing security guard and usual duties. 2nd Heavy Destroyer Platoon advanced into the town of Hadjeb and occupied the town taking gun positions and patrolling the town. No contact was made with enemy.

23 - March.

Sbiba, North Africa bivouac area performing security guard and usual duties. 2nd Heavy Destroyer Platoon occupied positions in Hadjeb and were shelled by enemy artillery, and attacked by enemy infantry at 7:00 A.M. Sergeant Cherry's Destroyer Section and Sergeant Hicks A.A. Section held off the infantry attack while the remainder of the platoon withdrew to new positions. WOUNDED: Sergeant Cherry, Technician Fifth Grade Lefevers, Technician Fifth Grade, Sheremeta.

24 - March.

Sbiba, North Africa bivouac area performing security guard and outpost duties. 2nd Heavy Destroyer Platoon occupied positions in the town of Hadjeb during the day returning to Sbiba bivouac area at 11:30 P.M. Distance traveled 51 miles.

25 - March.

Sbiba, North Africa bivouac area performing guard and outpost duties.

26 - March.

Hadjeb, North Africa bivouac area left Sbiba 9:00 P.M. arrived Hadjeb 1:00 A.M. the 27th. Distance traveled 51 miles.

Pichon, North Africa. Left bivouac area 6 miles N.E. of Hadjeb at 5:00 A.M. 8th arrived at Pichon, 8:00 A.M. Occupied positions firing 33 rounds of 75mm. Left Pichon 7:00 P.M. 9th arriving at bivouac 6 miles N.E. Hadjeb at 11:00 P.M.

10 - April.

Bivouac area 6 miles N.E. Hadjeb, North Africa. Engaged in patrol activities in pass east of Hadjeb. KILLED IN ACTION BY ENEMY MINE: Cpl. Redicker, Pvt. Carlyle Lamm. WOUNDED IN ACTION BY ENEMY MINE: Private Avis.

11 - 14 April.

Bivouac area 6 miles N.E. Hadjeb, North Africa. Performing guard and usual camp duties.

15 - April.

Bivouac area 7 miles S.E. Maktar, North Africa. Left Hadjeb area 8:00 P.M. arrived at bivouac 12:30 A.M. 16th,. Distance traveled 46 miles.

16 - 20 April.

Bivouac area 7 miles S.E. Maktar, North Africa. Usual camp duties.

24 - April.

Bivouac area 3 miles S.W. Roumes - Souk, North Africa. Left bivouac area Maktar 5:30 P.M. 23rd. Arrived bivouac area Roumes - Souk. Distance traveled 102 miles.

Bivouac area 21 miles east of Beja. Usual camp duties.

M A Y - 1 9 4 3

1 - May.

Bivouac area at HILL 609. Left bivouac area 21 miles east of Beja 5:00 A.M. arrived at HILL 609, 6:00 A.M. The column was bombed and strafed by enemy aircraft at 6:00 A.M. positions were attacked by enemy aircraft at 9:00 A.M. Enemy artillery fire fell in the area throughout the day. Performing guard and outpost duties. Distance traveled 9 mi.

2 - 3 May.

Bivouac area at hill 609 North Africa. Performing guard and outpost duties

4 - May.

Bivouac area 5 miles east of Hill 609. Left Hill 609 at 3:00 P.M. arrived at new bivouac 5:00 P.M. Distance traveled 5 miles.

5 - May.

Bivouac area 6 miles south of Hill 609. Left old bivouac area 11:00 A.M. arrived at new bivouac 12:00 noon. Distance traveled 6 miles. Usual guard and camp duties.

6 - 7 May.

Bivouac area 6 miles south of Hill 609. Performing guard and usual camp duties.

8 - May.

Bivouac area 4 miles west of Tebourba, North Africa. Left old bivouac 7:00 P.M. arrived at new bivouac 9:00 P.M. Distance traveled 18 miles.

Bivouac area 4 miles west of Tebourba, North Africa engaged in Patrolling Assigned area, taking several prisoners. Usual camp duties.

Bivouac area 18 miles west of Tebourba, North Africa. Left old bivouac area 3:00 P.M. arrived at new area 4:00 P.M. Distance traveled 14 miles.

12 - 18 May.

Bivouac area 18 miles west of Tebourba, North Africa. Usual camp duties.

19 - May.

Bizerte, North Africa. Left old bivouac area 8:00 A.M. arrived Bizerte, 11:30 P.M. distance traveled 43 miles. Usual duties and recreation.

20 - May.

Bivouac area 15 miles west of Tebourba, North Africa. Left Bizerte 2:00 P.M. arrived at bivouac area 4:30 P.M. Distance traveled 43 miles.

21 - 29 May.

Bivouac area 18 miles west of Tebourba, North Africa. Usual camp duties.

30 - May.

Bivouac area 8 miles south west of Bizerte. Left bivouac 18 miles west of Tebourba 8:00 A.M. arrived new bivouac 10:30 distance traveled 51 miles.

31 - May.

Bivouac area 8 miles North of Bizerte. Usual camp duties.

Bivouac area near Port Farina, North Africa. Left bivouac area near Bizerte 10:00 A.M. arrived at bivouac 2:30 P.M. Distance traveled 44 miles by motor convoy.

13 - 31 August.
