8 April 45

Bn Hdq, Hdq Co. and Rcn Co. (-) located in Bromskirchen, Germany (G619780) providing local security for part of town. Bn remained atchd 7th AD. 1st plat Rcn Co. remained atchd to B Co. and 2nd plat Rcn Co remained atchd to A Co.

A Co. remained atchd 47 Inf Regt, 9th Inf Div. Co Hdq and 1st plat located in Olsberg (G5206) 2nd plat vic Eversberg (G422075) 3rd plat vic Whrstapel (G421062)

B Co. remained atchd CCR with Co (less 2nd plat) further atchd to 38 AIB supporting attack towards Fredeberg (G4088) 1st plat fired 1 rd APC and 6 rds HE during this attack, destroying one enemy OP and one mortar, vic (G423875) 2nd plat was further atchd to 40th Tk Bn. which moved from vic Winterburg to vic Fredeberg (G418875)

C Co. remained atchd to CCB with Co (less 2nd plat) further atchd T/F Beatty; 1st plat further atchd to T/F Erlenbusch and 3rd plat further atchd T/F Rhea. During period Co CP moved from Winkhausen to vic Wormbach (G375859) 1st plat sptd attack of T/F Erlenbusch N from Selkentrop (G335855) 2nd plat occupied road block positions vic Wormbach (G365855) with T/F Beatty. 3rd plat sptd attack of T/F Rhea N from Fredeberg (G4088)

9 April 45

Bn Hdq, Hdq Co and Rcn Co. (-) moved from Bromskirchen at 0700 and closed in new area vic Neu Astenberg (G522860) at 0815. Bn Coordinated movement of Div Trps to new area.

A Co. 3rd plat fired 19 rds covering fire, vic Wehstaple (G4206) Co relieved of atchmt 9th Inf Div and reverted to control of CCA at 0800 hrs. Moved from Olsberg to assembly area vic Gleidorf (G401856) closing at 1930.

B Co. (less 2nd plat) moved with T/F Griffen (38 AIB from Fredeburg along route Berghausen-Winkhausen (G3390) 1st plat fired 3 rds HE knocking out 1 enemy OP and 1 unidentified tank vic G337897) 2nd plat moved with T/F Wolfe from vic Fredeburg toward Dorlar (G3491) 1 EM in 3rd plat wounded by mortar fire during period.

C Co. Co CP located in vic Bracht (G305856) 1st plat moved with T/F Erlenbusch toward Berghausen and high ground vic (G325857) thence west toward vic (G290882) 2nd plat moved with T/F Beatty toward Berghausen, Obr Berndorf and thence to Kukelheim (G3286) destroying one AT Gun. 3rd plat moved with T/F Rhea from vic Gleidorf to Felbecke (G3485), Obr Berndorf (G3487) Arpe (G3287) Obr Landenbach (G3189) Hemminghausen (G 3089) and Kobbenrode (G2989) destroying 2 SP guns and taking 12 FWs. Total rds fired 25 HE and 2 APC.



10 April 45

Bn Hdq, Hdq Co and Rcn Co. (-) moved from vic Neu Astenberg and closed in Schmalleburg (G385831) at 1100. Bn coordinated movement 203 AAA (-) and 33 Eng (-) to vic Fredeburg. Held 87 Rcn of responsibility for Schmalleburg and placed guard on six German hospitals and coordinated security of town with Div Tns. Made plans for civilian control and evacuated 52 German Soldiers to PWE. Supervised military gov. functions of Div Trps in Fredeburg. Responsibility for the town assumed by Div Tns Cmdr at 1800 but Bn cont furnishing 2 roadblocks and guards.

A Co. moved with CCA from vic Gledorf to assy posns vic Arpe. 1st plat moved with T/F Rhea to Isingheim (G297924) firing 2 rds HE at enemy in buildings in town. 2nd Plat atchd to T/F Wemple occupied roadblocks posn vic Kukulheim (G321425) 3rd Plat moved with T/F Daily from vic Schwartmeck to Ober Valbert and Schonfelt firing 4 rds APC at SP gun and 7 rds HE at enemy personnel and wheeled vehicles destroying 1GP truck and trailer.

B Co. Cp moved from Ndr Berndorf to Lochtrop (G328925) closing at 1530 1st and 2nd plats moved with T/F Brown to vic Bremke (G3395) and occupied roadblock posns. 3rd plat moved with T/F Griffen to G300944) between Brenscheide and Eslohe firing 4 rds APC at a Tiger Tank which withdrew and 3 rds at buildings occupied by enemy.

C Co CP located vic Kukulheim (G279926) 1st plat moved with T/F Erlenbusch to Leckmarth, Schwartmeck, Obr Marpe and Dornecke (G265912) 2nd plat moved with T/F Beatty from Kukulheim to Bracht Odingen and North thru Elms 99 Inf Div to vic Kobbenrode. 3rd plat moved with T/F Chappius from Kukulheim generally north firing 5 rds APC knocking out 2 SP guns. Also fired approx 10 rds APC and 100 rds HE knocking out 4 SP guns, 1 Rcn vehicle 3 sedans, 3 Sedans, 2 wagons, 1 wrecker, 1 MK VI, 1 four wheel trailer, 2 cargo trucks 1 six wheel armoured car, 3 MK IVs 1 AT gun (88MM) and damaging 1 MK V. 21 PWs were taken. All of this damage was done when plat caught an enemy column on road vic Kobbenrode(G295890) and destroyed the column.

11 April 45

Bn Hdq, Hdq Co and Rcn Co (-) remained in S chmalleburg(G385831) Hdq took 5 PWs and Rcn Co took 6 PWs vic town during security operations.

A Co. moved with CCA to an assembly posn vic Eslohe. During the move 1st plat fired 2 rds HE at bldgs and 3rd plat fired 7 rds HE and 4 rds APC at a convoy, destroying 1 cargo truck and trailer.

B Co moved with CCR T/Fs to the following locations: 1st plat G316969, 2nd plat G312987, 3rd plat in Eslohe (G-3095) At 1800 1st and 2nd plats moved to G305993 and were atchd to T/F Brown. 3rd plat moved to G275006 and was atchd to T/F Griffen.

C Co CP and 2nd plat located in Ober Salivey with T/F Beatty at end of period, plat fired 4 rds HE at enemy Inf. 1st plat moved with T/F Erlenbusch from Dornecke to Schlipruthen. 3rd plat moved with T/F Chappuis to Ndr Salivey firing 15 rds HE and 15 rds APC destroying 1 20 MM gun(AA) and damaging 1 MK VI tank; also fired on camouflaged positions and houses, and took 17 PWs



12 April 45

Bn(-) moved from Schmallenburg and closed in vic Bremke (G321952) at 1445. CP personnel picked up 7 PWs during the period. 3rd plat Rcn Co took 14 PWs vic Grevenstein (G275006)

A Co. remained in previous positions.

B Co. moved with CCR from vic Grevenstein to locations as follows: Co CP and 1st plat in Kuntrop (B060986) 2nd plat in Neuenrade (B035983) 3rd plat in Garbeck (B070023) During the period 1st plat assisted in taking about 150 PWs; 2nd plat fired 10 rds HE, 7 rds APC, 2000 rds .50 cal and about 1000 rds .30 cal M.G. fire, destroying 1 MK III tank, 4 Halftracks, 2 20 MM AA guns, and approx 35 misc vehicles. This plat took approx 400 PWs and assisted with the taking of numerous other PWs. One TD was slightly damaged and 1 EM was wounded by bazooka fire. 3rd plat assisted in taking approx 150 PWs During this period it was almost impossible to claim an accurate number of PWs for the Plats. due to the fluid situation with Germans being rounded up on all sides, walking in groups to give up and coming in convoys, complete with vehicles, to give up. The plats worked with the T/Fs taking numerous PWs but claim credit for only those taken by the plats.

C Co. moved with CCB to vic Brachhausen (B136005) and Amecke (B100062)

13 April 45

Bn (-) made no change. Around midnight, an enemy halftrack, attempted to follow several Engr trucks past our guard, but when vehicle failed to halt, when ordered to do so, guards opened fire and disabled vehicle but personnel escaped. 1 Sec 1st plat Rcn established outpost vic Neuenrade (B032982) and recd arty fire, resulting in 2 EM being wounded. 1 Sec 1st plat Rcn recd heavy mortar fire in Garbeck (B068022) which slightly damaged 1 M-8.

A Co CP moved to vic Kasberg. 1st plat atchd T/F Rhea moved to vic Volkringhausen, thence W to Honnethal, firing 17 rds HE destroying 1 ammo dump and 2 cargo trucks. 2nd plat atchd to T/F Wemple, moved to vic Honnethal, firing 6 rds HE covering fire and 1000 rds .50 cal which destroyed 1 half track. 3rd plat moved to vic Deilinghofen (B048088) with T/F Dailey.

B Co. remained in same posns except that 1st plat moved from Kuntrop to Neuenrade to assist 2nd Plat in repulsing counter-attacks but returned to former posn. 2nd plat fired 4 rds APC destroying 1 MK VI tank and 1 abandoned assault gun.

C Co moved with CCB to vic Langholthausen and Kasberg.

14 April 45.

During afternoon 20th April patrol from Rcn Co. contacted 3 Ger soldiers vicinity C360180. These men attempted to escape capture and patrol killed 1 officer and 1 EM. The third man escaped.
