4th Feb. 1945

- Bn. Hq., Hq. Co., & Rcn. Co. remained in billets in Limbourg, Bel., (K-729255) performing maintenance and training.
- A Co. in billets in La Bruyere, Bel., (K-742306) continued performing maintenance and training; attached to CCA, 7th A D.
- B Co (- Co. Hq..Plat.) moved from Membach, Bel., (K-771256) to an assembly position vicinity Simmerath, Germany, (K-985240) during the night preparing to support attach of CCR on Strauch and Steckenborn, Germany. 1st Plat. operating with T/F McDaniels and 3rd Plat. with T/F Lutz. CCR, 7th A D, attached to and operating in 78th Inf. Div. Zone.
- C Co. in billets in Heggen, Bel., (K-750285) continued performing maintenance and training; attached to CCB, 7th AD, which was placed on 6-hour alert status at 1140.

5th Feb. 1945

- Bn. Hq., Hq. Co., Rcn., A & C Companies: No change.
- B Co., with 1st & 2nd Plats. atchd. T/F McDaniels and 3rd Plat. atchd. T/F Lutz, supported attach of CCR on Strauch and Steckenborn, Ger. 1st & 2nd Plats. fired no rounds but 3rd Plat., from positions in vicinity Steckenborn (F-029263), knocked out 8 pillboxes, 1 towed 88 mm AT gun, and captured one 75 mm AT gun NE and NW of the town at ranges of approx. 400 yds; fired 29 rds AP and 44 rds. HE; 28 men surrendered to the Inf. as result of this firing. Co. CP established in Simmerath, Ger., (K-985240). 1st & 2nd Plats. remained in position vic. Strauch (F-0126).

6th Feb. 1945

- Bn. Hq., Hq. Co., Rcn. and A Companies: No change.
- B Co.: 1st & 2nd Plats. remained in defensive positions vic. Strauch (F-0126) reporting no activity. 3rd Plat., operating with 311 IR, supported attack on Hechelscheid, Ger., (F-036271), which was taken at 0930. Plat. fired 9 rds. AP and 6 rds. HE, knocking out 6 pillboxes. 47 prisoners surrendered to Inf. as result of firing on pillboxes.
- C Co. removed from 6-hour alert status at 1430. Continued training and maint.

7th Feb. 1945

- 814 TD (- B Co.) alerted to move to zone of 99th Inf. Div. after 080800.
- A Co relieved from attachment to CCA, 7th AD, and reverted to Bn. control at 1630. Co. continued maintenance and training.
- B Co. remained in defensive positions receiving light mortar and artillery fire during period.
- C Co. relieved from attachment to CCB, 7th AD, and reverted to Bn. control at 1630. 190 rds. HE fired on Leopold Dam range at stationary targets.

11th Feb. 1945

814 TD Bn. (- B Co.) remained attached to 99th Inf. Div. Bn. CP located in Bullingen, Bel., (K-955024). Bn. Rear CP, Hq. Co. & Rcn. Rear remained in Dolhain.

Rcn. Co. CP remained with Bn. CP. 1st Plat. remained attached to A Co. and 2nd Plat. remained attached to C Co. 3rd Plat, 2nd Sec., furnished security for Bn. CP.

A Co. (-3rd Plat.) further attached to 106 Inf. Div. for operations. 3rd Plat. attached to 99th Inf. Div.

B Co. remained attached to CGR, 7th AD, in positions vicinity Steckenborn and Hechelscheid.

C Co. remained attached to 99th Inf. Div.

12th Feb. 1945

Bn. made no change in locations.

A Co., 3rd Plat., received intermittent artillery fire in Udenbreth, Germany, but suffered no damage or casualties.

C Co. (- 2nd Plat.) now attached to 69th Inf. Div. due to relief of 395th Inf. Regt. by 271st Inf. Regt. 1st Plat. received intermittent artillery fire in Hollerath, Germany, but suffered no damage or casualties..

13th Feb. 1945

Bn. (- B Co.) now attached 69th Inf. Div. as 69th relieved 99th Inf. Div. at 1000. A Co. (- 3rd Plat.) remains further attached to 106th Inf. Div. There was no change in any locations. Rcn. Plats. made reconnaissance of Helenthal/Hollerath area for firing positions and possible crossing sites on Prether River. 3rd Plat. A Co. received mortar and small arms fire in Udenbreth and had one M-20 damaged but had no casualties.

14th Feb. 1945

Bn. made no change in locations. 1st Plat. C Co. received mortar fire in Hollerath, Germany, but had no damage or casualties.

15th Feb. 1945

Bn. made no change.

16th Feb. 1945

Bn. (- B Co.) relieved of attachment to 69th & 106th Inf. Divs. on completion of relief by 661st TD Bn. at 1330 and simultaneously re-attached to 7th A D. Bn. (- B Co.) closed in assembly area vicinity Bullingen (K-955024) at 1400 to await V Corps order to move to 7th AD area. Rcn. Plats. remained attached to A and C Cos.

B Co. made no change.

A Co., with C Co. work detail attached, closed in area vicinity Kalterherberg, Ger., K-908143, at 1730 to work under supervision 207th Engr. Bn. 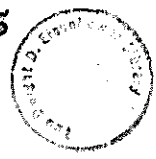

25 Feb 45

Bn remained attached to 7th AD with B Co further attached to CCR. Bn Hq. and Rcn Rear moved from Dolhain, Bel. 0900 and closed in Baelen, Bel. (K751272) 1000. Instruction for 825th TD Bn personnel on M-36 Destroyer continued. Bn continued to furnish 285 EM, plus officers, for road maintenance work. A, B and C Companies furnished 75 men each and Rcn Co furnished 60 men. Rcn Co (with B Co work detail attached) located vicinity Kalterherberg, Germany, K-916147 working under supervision 164th Engr. Bn. A Co (with C Co. work detail attached) located vicinity Kalterherberg, Germany, (K-908143) working under supervision 207th Engr. Bn. A Co rear detachment remained with destroyers in Bullingen, Bel., with C Co. B Co (less work detail) remained in Bullingen, Bel. STECKENBORN AND HECHELSCHIED, GER. C Co (LESS WORK DETAIL) REMAINED IN BULLINGEN, BEL.

26th Feb. 45

Bn. continued to furnish men for road maintenance work. Instruction for 825th TD Bn personnel continued, firing 60 rds. HE on Leopold Dam Range.

27th Feb 45

At 1730 A Co, with C Co work detail attached, released from road maintenance work, remaining in place. Rcn. Co., with B Co work detail attached, continued working on roads. Instruction for 825th TD Bn personnel concluded. No change in locations of other units.

28th Feb 45

A Co., with C Co. work detail attached, returned to Bullingen, Bel., (K952021) closing in area at 1200. Rcn Co., with B Co. work detail attached, released from road maintenance work at 1730 but remained in place. Personnel from 825th TD Bn departed 0900 for parent unit.

1 March 1945

Rcn Co. moved from Kalterherberg, Ger., and closed in Membach, Bel., at 1400. B Co. work detail rejoined company at 1200. All units continued concurrent training and maintenance of equipment.

2 March 45

All units remained in place performing maintenance of vehicles and making preparations for future operations. 1st Platoon and 1 Squad Pioneer Plat., Rcn. Co., attached to B Co. and arrived in Hechelscheid at 1500. For the coming operation B Co. further attached as follow: 1st Plat. to T/F Chappius; 2nd Plat. to T/F Brown; 3rd Plat. to T/F Griffin in reserve initially.

3 March 45

Bn Hq., Hq Co. and Rcn (-) remained in place. A Co. moved from Bullingen, Bel., to an assembly area vicinity Konzen, Germany, K-954220, arriving at 1130 and becoming attached to CCA on arrival. 1st Plat. further attached to T/F Rhea and 2nd Plat. further attached to T/F Wemple for operations. 2nd Plat. and 1 Squad Pioneer Plat. attached to A Co. for operations, arriving in area vicinity Konzen, Ger., at 1130 B Company remained in vicinity of Steckenborn. C Co. moved from Bullingen and closed in area vicinity Witzerath, Germany, K-989255 at 1215, becoming attached to CCB at that time.
