Bn. remained atchd 7th AD. Bn Hdq. Hdq.Co. and Rcn Co (-) located in Villip, Germany (F5426) No change was made during this period.

A Co. located in Liessem (F5927) with 2nd Plat. and 1 Squad Pioneer Plat. Rcn Co. atchd for operational control. Co. atchd CCA and Co. (-1 Plat) further atchd to 489 A FA Bn. on indirect fire mission, firing 150 rds HE unobserved at targets E of Rhine River. 1st Plat. further atchd to 23 AIB on direct fire missions from positions along Rhine River between Rolandseck and Oberwinter, Germany.

B Co. located vic Bad Godesberg, Germany atchd CCR with 1st Plat and 1 Squad Pioneer Plat. Rcn Co. atchd for operational control. Co. less 2nd Plat. further atchd 440 AFA Bn. firing 120 rds HE unobserved at targets E of Rhine River. 2nd Plat occupied direct fire positions along Rhine River vic Bad Godesberg under control CCR

21 March 45

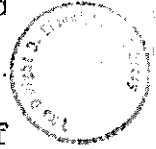

SUMMARY OF OPERATIONS

FROM: 25 March 1945
TO : 31 March 1945

25 March 45

Bn. Hq., Hq Co and Rcn Co (-) left Villip, Ger. at 0215 and closed in Hargarten, Ger. (F714208) at 0430. Bn coordinated movement of Div Troops. Rcn (-) furnished bivouac guard for an CP.

A Co. moved from vic Hesseln to vic Ehlscheide, Ger. 1st Plat. atchd TF Rhea destroyed one SP 88 mm gun and one 20 mm gun. 3 MM were wounded and track knocked off one M-36 but was repaired. 2nd Plat atchd TF Wemple. Co (-) atchd TF King with Capt. Randall acting as TF Ex Off.

B Co moved from vic Notscheid to vic Gierend (F847184). 1st Plat and 2nd Plat with TF Brown, 3rd Plat operating with TF Griffin.

C Co. moved from vic. Olenberg to vic Vettelschoss, Ger. (F7224) with CCB.

26 March 45

Bn Hq, Hq Co and Rcn Co (-) moved from Hargarten to vic Kurtscheid, Ger and then during the night to vic Nordhofen (G016135) arriving 27 0700.

A Co moved with CCA from vic Ehlscheid to vic Deesen, Ger. Hq Sec captured 25 prisoners.

B Co moved from Gierend, Ger. to an assembly area vic (G275065). Plats continued operating with same TFs. 1st Plat knocked out 10 misc vehicles and 2nd Plat knocked out 25 misc vehicles with MG and SA fire. 3rd Plat destroyed 13 misc vehicles, 1 AT gun and 1 tank (type unidentified) firing 30 rds. HE. Lt Rose, Plat. Cmdr. 2nd Plat destroyed 1 Panther tank with a thermite grenade. Capt. Lazaros, Co Cmdr, liberated 46 Allied PWs.

C Co. moved to vic Puderbach, Ger. with CCB.

27 March 45

Bn. Hq., Hq Co and Rcn (-) departed Nordhofen 1015, arr Willemsrod (G178159) 1230, deptsd Willemsrod 1630, arr Holzhausen 2145.

A Co moved to Ehringhausen, Ger. 1st Plat fired 46 rds HE at troop concentrations in Wwedord. 2nd Plat. fired 6 rds APC and 8 rds HE destroying 2 railroad ammunition trains (no. cars not known). 3rd Plat. fired 10 rds HE at troops and destroyed 1 truck, 4 rds APC and destroyed 1 Mk V tank. The Plat. also captured 20 PWs. Atchd 2nd Plat Rcn Co fired 37 mm, MG and SA at troop concentrations and rounded up and guarded PWs for TF King

B Co operated with TFs holding positions as follows: 1st Plat. vic G247235, 2nd Plat vic G435245, 3rd Plat vic G413263.

C Co moved to vic Steinen, Ger., where 2nd Plat received 15-20 rds from enemy SP gun. No. 3 gun fired 2 rds HE and No. 1 gun fired 1 rd AP with no visible results but enemy fire ceased. 2nd Plat. also took 20 prisoners in Rorsbach. 3rd Plat fired 3 rds HE knocking out a half track in Seck, Ger.

28 March 45

Bn Hq, Hq Co and Rcn Co (9) deptsd vic Holzhausen 1130 and arr



vic Hohensolms G534285 at 1530.
 A Co moved to vic Giessen, Ger. 3rd Plat and 2nd Plat Rcn captured 75 PWs and liberated 800 American PWs and 200 misc Allied PWs at Dutenhofen.
 B Co moved with TFs to vic Bellenhausen G695345. 2nd Plat destroyed 4 track PMS, 3 cmd cars, 5 cargo trucks loaded with gas, arms and ammunition and captured 14 PWs, firing 3 rds APC and 5 rds. HE.
 During this move Lt. Col. Brown, TF Cmdr., was ambushed and captured and 2nd Plat was quite instrumental in effecting his rescue.
 C Co moved to vic Ronhausen, Ger. with CCB.

29 March 45

Bn Gq, Hq Co and Rcn Co (9) deptd Hohensolms 1015 and arr vic Heskem G773395 at 1400. Rcn Co (-) employed on mission of reconnoitering and securing area to be occupied during which they captured several towns, took 24 PWs and liberated a group of Allied PWs. During the afternoon machine gunners fired on several enemy planes.
 A Co moved from Giessen to Nordeck, Ger. 2nd Plat. fired on enemy planes. Atchd 2nd Plat Rcn Co performed road rcn mission.
 B Co moved to vic G797469. Resistance encountered in Kirchain, fired 3 rds APC and 4 rds HE destroying ~~an~~ OP and a 20 mm gun.
 C Co moved to vic Kirchain and Diedenbach, Ger. 2nd Plat supported infantry in taking Kirchain bz occupying road block positions and firing on snipers in town. Took 12 PWs. 3rd Plat. fired 10 rds HE destroying one 88 mm gun, one 20 mm gun, 1 Half track, 1 rcn vehicle, 1 cycle and killing 18 German soldiers, capturing 26 PWs.

30 March 45

Bn Hq, Hq Co and Rcn Co (-) deptd ~~xxxxxxx~~ Heskem 1100 and arr vic Frankenau G847782 at 2200. Rcn Co captured 8 PWs.
 A Co moved to vic Haubern, Ger. Capt. Randall aptd Trains Guard Cmdr. for CCA. Hq Sec, 3rd Plat and 2nd Plat Rcn rld from atchmt TF King and atchd to Trains Guard. 1st Plat. reld from TF Rhea.
 B Co reached Frankenau and then occupied positions as follows: 1st Plat. G882868, 2nd Plat. G910873, 3rd Plat. G818847. No action.
 C Co moved to positions as follows: Hq and 2nd Plat in Giflitz G9785, 1st Plat in Edersee G924876, 3rd Plat in Mehlen G958859.

31 March 1945

Bn Hq, Hq Co and Rcn Co(9) made no change in position. Rcn (-) performed rcn of surrounding area capturing 3 PWs and destroying 1 vehicle. At close of period 1st Rcn.
