

HEAUQUARTERS 823 TANK DESTROYER BATTALION
ST. MAUR (921218) BELGIUM

7 SEPTEMBER, 1944

GREETINGS:

THIS HEADQUARTERS CROSSED THE BELGIAN BONDER AT 03 SEPTEMBER 1944, AND STARTED TO SET UP ITS COMMAND POST IN THE WOUDS SOUTHWEST OF ST. MAUR. BEFORE BECOMING COMPLETELY SET UP WORD WAS RECEIVED THAT 25 GER-MANS NERE, WITHOUT PERMISSION FROM AMBOT, ALSO ATTEMPTING TO OCCUPY SAID WOODS. IN HIGH DISPLEASURE AT SUCH PROCEDURE THIS HEADQUARTERS IMMEDIATELY PACKED UP AND MOVED OUT BAG AND BAGGAGE LEAVING THE GERMANS IN TEMPORARILY UNDISPUTED POSSESSION. WE THEN SURROUNDED THE AREA AND WHEN OUR BEST THRONED GERMAN DID NOT VOLUNTARILY EVICT THE UNAUTHORIZED TENANTS, STRONGER METHOUS. EG. 30 CAL AND EC CAL MACHINE GUAS, WERE RESORTED to. RESPONSE ON THE PART OF THE GER-MANS NOT BEING JP TO THE STANDARD WE ARE ACCUSTOMED TO, ARTILLERY AND MARTIAR FIRE WAS CALLED FOR. THIS FIRE CHUSED IT GREAT IMPROVEMENT IN ANGLE -CEL COUNT RELATIONS AND SOME GERMANS SURRENDERED, NOT TO MENTION THOSE WOUNDED AND/OR DEAD WHO COULDN'S. WHEN THIS HEADQUARTERS AND INFANTRY FINALLY STROLLED THROUGH THE DELIGNTFUL TREES AND BUSHES, WITH FIXED BAYONETS, THERE WAS COMPLETE MAR-EEMENT ON ALL FOIRTS AND ALL SURVIVING GERMANS SURRENDERED UNCONDITIONALLY THE FINAL COUNT BEING 91 CAPTURED WITH 7 KILLED.

BY ABOUT 1600 HOURS THE HEADQUARTERS WAS NICELY SET UP IN THE "C-ATEAU" AND GROUNDS WHERE WE REMAINED FOR SEVERAL DAYS AT WHICH TIME WE MOVED ON TOWARD THE FINAL OBJECTIVE. DURING THIS TIME OUR UNIT WAS ROYALLY ENTERTRINED AND TREATED BY THE BELGIANS AND THE PEOPLE OF THE CHATERU.

TO THE PEPPLE OF BELGIUM WE BRING THE GOOD WISHES OF OUR COURTRY AND HOPE FOR YOUR BARLY LIBERATION. TO MONSIEUR MASSON AND THE FOLKS OF "CHATERU" OUR HEARTY THANKS FOR A VERY PLEASANT STAY AND MAY PEACE AND PROSPERITY BE YOURS IN THE COMING YEARS.
