SUBJECT: Periodic Report. (Period 1800 5 May 45- 1800 6 May 45)

TO : COMMANDING GENERAL, I CORPS APO #301 (Attn: COL GOODYEAR, G-4)

1. Enemy Action and Countermeasures-
 - a. At 1100 6 May, Military Police at BINALONAN reported five (5) Japs 3,000 yards north of SAN FELIPE (LUZON 1/50,000 839.4-1946.2). Thirty men and one tractor reached a two square mile area surrounding point Japs were reported. Civilians indicated three or four Japs who appeared hungry and undernourished had been sleeping under a tree at 0900 6 May in area reported, but had left. Three bamboo carts were found in the mountains north of where Japs were seen, but no Japs could be found. (See overlay)

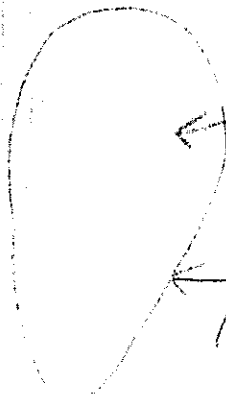
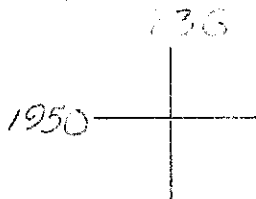

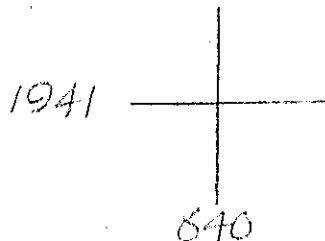

SUBJECT: Periodic Report. (Period 1800 14 May 45-- 1800 15 May 45)

TO : COMMANDING GENERAL, I CORPS. APO #301. (Attn: COL GOODYEAR G-4)

1. Enemy action and countermeasures-

a. At 1500 15 May, I Corps reported reported Japs at CABARUAN (825.1-1929.4) (See Overlay). Three tractors, 20 EM and 30 Guerrillas joined 36th M.P.s at CABARUAN and overran Jap position against light enemy fire. Approximately 12 Japs were seen running from area. Two Japs were found dead; one Jap wore us Army fatigues. The other was a Jap medical officer, he carried a Jap saber, morphine and a thermometer. The inclosed documents were found. Fleeing Japs were tracked 1,000 yards on Y Az of 66°. Tracks were lost and Japs could not be located. The terrain is hilly, rough and full of tall grass.

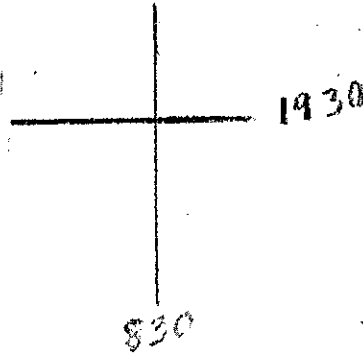

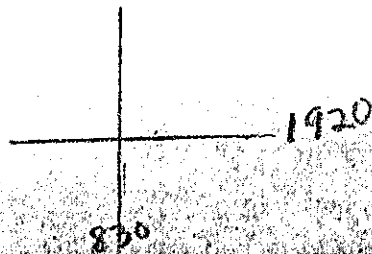


Co. "B" 826 AMPH TRACTOR BN 15 MAY 45

SUBJECT: Periodic Report. (Period 1800 28 May 45 - 1800 29 May 45)

TO: COMMANDING GENERAL, I CORPS, APO 301. (Attn: Col GOODYEAR G-4)

1. Enemy Action and Countermeasures-
 - a. 29 May 45- Received report of seven Japs in vicinity of Post #16 at approx 1200. Patrol investigated and found that one Jap had killed one guerrilla of a SAN CARLOS Hq. A search was made but the Jap was not found. Later in the evening a Jap was captured in the vicinity. Approx. location of patrol (826-1940)
 - b. 29 May 45- Civilian reported ten Japs butchering a cow in vicinity of Post #15- patrol investigated and found remains of cow in vicinity at approx (838-1951). Japs were reported to have continued on into the hills. One civilian was reported to have been abducted by them. Time of patrolling was 1100-1800. Some Japs have been previously reported as having been seen in the vicinity of MANADAG and headed towards the hills- they were said to have numbered nine and were loading a cow. Very possibly the same group.
