Telephoned Capt ADAMS, CO A Co at RIZAL (0895.0-1900.7) and gave orders to occupy GURBA (0855.5-1894.5) with approx 20 guerrillas from LUPAO (0870.8-1920.8); occupy SANTI DOMINGO (0868.2-1885.5) with approx 20 guerrillas from LICAB (0854.5-1980.4). Ordered A Co, 326th Amph Trac Bn to make survey bridges in assigned area submit ~~and~~ recommendations for number of bridge-installations needing guarding, number pers required, and plan to take over when required. Ordered Co A, this orgn, to see that unit or units occupying Market Place at SAN JOSE and School House at LUPAO, evacuate same immediately, as directed G-3, per Serial No. 1 above. Ordered coordination with PCAU & civilian administrations in assigned area and establish means of communication should any barrier or town need AF or other military assistance in repelling enemy or putting down civilian disturbances. Co A to establish daily patrols in assigned areas as of 6 June 1945.
