G O #1

1. G O #22 this Hq, dated 25 October 1943, as amended, Subject, Guard orders is rescinded, and the following is substituted therefor:

a. The Interior Guard for this Battalion will be established under the provisions of FM 26-5 with the exception of Par 13 g & h.

b. The personnel of the guard will be as follows:

- 1-Officer of the Day
- 1-Sergeant of the Guard
- 1-Corporal of the Guard
- 68-Privates of the Guard

(1) Each Company will furnish two (2) privates of the Guard *detail* daily. The Sergeant and the Corporal of the Guard will be furnished by companies in accordance with the Schedule published by this Headquarters.

c. The uniform of the guard will be Class "C" with helmet liners, suspenders/and cartridge belt. Additional outer clothing necessary may be prescribed by the Battalion Officer of the Day, dependent upon weather conditions.

d. All ~~guards~~ <sup>ENLISTED MEMBERS OF THE GUARD</sup> except the Sergeant of the Guard will be armed with a carbine. The Sergeant of the Guard will not be armed. The new guard will be marched to the Battalion Armory prior to 1600 hours daily to draw their weapons. Each enlisted man will sign for his own weapon and will keep it with him at all times. He will not leave the guard house without it. The Sergeant of the Guard will have all guards at the Battalion Armory from 0800 to 0830 to clean their weapons. The guards will return to training after cleaning their weapons. On Saturday weapons will be drawn prior to 1130 hours.

e. Guard mount will be held daily except Saturday and Sunday, at 1745 behind Battalion Headquarters. On Saturday and Sunday guard mount will be held at 1130 hours, after guard mount the guard will be marched ~~to~~ to Group Guard House #1.

f. The guard will consist of two posts as follows:

(1) Post #1 contains the area bounded by 24th Street, Park Ave., 25th St and Leon Drive. The sentry will not walk Leon Drive but will cut behind the north end of Battalion Headquarters and go across the field and around Recreation Building #8201.

Special Orders for Post #1: I will be especially watchful for fires and persons trying to break into unoccupied buildings.

(2) Post #2 is the area around the Battalion Motor Pool.

Special Orders for Post #2: I will be especially watchful for fires and for any unauthorized persons who try to gain entrance to the motor pool. I will allow no vehicles to be removed from the Motor Pool without the permission of the Officer of the Day.

g. The tour of duty for Post #1 will be from 1800 until Reveille. The tour of duty for Post #2 will be from 1800 until the guard is relieved by members of the Battalion Motor Personnel. On Saturdays and Sundays, all posts will be twenty-four hour posts.


h. Additional duties of the Battalion Officers of the Day:

- (1) He will coordinate his activities with the officer designated as Group OD by the 24th TD Gp Headquarters.
- (2) He will relieve the Battalion Duty Officer for mess.
- (3) In case of fire he will comply with General Order #1, Hq 24th TD Gp 1944.
- (4) He will check the guard house at least once before and once after 2400.
- (5) He will report to the Adjutant at 1200 hours each day on the day that he goes on duty.
- (6) He will keep a close check on the police of the Battalion area and will take steps to keep the police maintained at all times. He will <sup>be</sup> particularly watchful on Sundays.

2. The provisions of the Above will apply until an official order is published.

GENERAL ORDERS NO. 3.

GUARD ORDERS

1. Par 1, GO #1, this Hq., dated 24 January 1944, and amendments thereto, are rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

a. An Interior Guard is established by this battalion in accordance with the provisions of FM 26-5, excepting par 13, g and h.

b. Personnel of the Guard:

- 1 - Officer of the Day
- 1 - Sergeant of the Guard
- 1 - Corporal of the Guard
- 6 - Privates of the Guard

c. The Battalion Officer of the Day and the Guard Detail will be assigned in accordance with weekly schedules published by this Headquarters.

d. Uniform of the Guard: Uniform "C", w/helmet liner, suspenders, pistol belt, and Carbine, cal. .30, M1. Outer clothing as prescribed by the 24th TD Group Officer of the Day.

e. The members of the Guard will be instructed in proper method of reporting fires, which is as follows: "To report a fire over fire alarm phones located on telephone poles at corners of Hq. Ave. and 24th St., and Park Ave. and 25th St., open door and remove telephone receiver from hook and listen for operator to answer. When operator has answered, give location of fire by saying (for example) "Fire in Co. "B" Mess Hall #384 on 24th St. between Hq. and Park Avenues." Then remain on line until operator repeats the number. When operator has repeated correct location, hang up receiver and wait for fire department. When fire department arrives, show the fireman in charge exact location of the fire. Then reporting a fire over regular communications telephone, call 3041 or operator. Use same procedure as required in using regular fire reporting phone."

f. Tour of Guard: Guard Mount at 1745 hours daily, except Sat. & Sun., in front of Bn. Hq. building. On Sat. & Sun. it will be held at 1300 hours. After Guard Mount, the Sergeant of the Guard will march the Guard Detail to the 24th TD Group Guard House #1, Bldg. 8320, located on corner of 24th St. and Hq. Avenue; and then post the 1st relief. The Guard detail will be relieved the following day at 0630 hours, except Sunday, when it will be relieved at 1300 hours.

g. Posts:

(1) Post #1. Area bounded by 24th St., Park Ave., 25th St., and Leon Drive. The Guard on post will walk in a counter-clockwise direction, keeping the buildings on his left.

(2) Post #2. Area bounded by 24th St., Park Ave., 25th St., and West Avenue. (Battalion Motor Pool). The Guard will walk on the interior of the area, keeping the buildings on his right.
