
Subject: Award of Bronze Star Medal.

To : Captain Manuel J. Carballeira, O 419 826, Medical Detachment,  
601st Tank Destroyer Battalion.

Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, you are awarded the Bronze Star Medal for valorous conduct in action against the enemy:

CITATION:

MANUEL J. CARBALLEIRA, O 419 826, Captain, Medical Corps, Medical Detachment, 601st Tank Destroyer Battalion. For valorous conduct in action against the enemy. On 3 March 1944, at 0500 hours, at \* \* \*, Italy, enemy artillery shells had set off a charge of TNT, killing two men and wounding 12 others. Although another group refused to go to the wounded men as it was not light enough to see the Red Cross on the ambulance, Captain CARBALLEIRA, upon hearing of these wounded men, immediately got into his ambulance and sped to them. He dressed their wounds and immediately evacuated them. He was exposed to direct artillery fire for more than 15 minutes. Residence: Flushing, New York.
