

1. By direction of the President, under the provisions of Executive Order 9419, 4 February 1944 (Sec. II, WD Bul. 3, 1944) a Bronze Star Medal (First Oak Leaf Cluster) is awarded to First Lieutenant (then Second Lieutenant) Robert L. Grannis, O1 826 411, 12th Infantry Regiment, for exemplary conduct in ground combat against the armed enemy on or about 24 January 1945 in the European Theater of Operations.

2. Authority for this award is contained in Par. 15.1e AR 600-45, and is based upon General Orders No. 10, Headquarters 12th Infantry Regiment dated 15 May 1945.
